

COMMON ONLINE RISKS


- Explicit videos that appear with one click
- Strangers who reach kids through games
- Algorithms that push unsafe videos
- Private messages adults never see
- Bullying that follows kids home

WHAT PARENTS CAN DO

- Keep screens in shared spaces
- Do not allow unsupervised screen time
- Turn on parental controls
- Disable live chat features
- Set strict screen time limits
- Delay social media accounts
- Model limited phone use
- Put devices away during family time

DID YOU KNOW?

- 57% of teens see self-harm or suicidal content online
- 46% of U.S. teens experience cyberbullying
- Most online harm happens before age 13
