Arrive in time for a **BOX LUNCH** included at the Cog Railway. There will be time for the gift shop and the museum too.

THE WORLDS FIRST MOUNTAIN CLIMBING COG RAILWAY. “Enjoy a Scenic Train Ride to the Summit of Mount Washington, the Northeast's Highest Peak! *Trains run Rain, Snow or Shine & may be Steam or Diesel powered.* The round-trip cog ride takes approximately three hours, generally including one hour stop at the summit. We recommend that you bring a camera and extra jacket or sweater. Remember, some trains are fired by coal -- so dress accordingly.” Quote excerpted from internet site.

- Your guests should be advised to bring warm clothes. You will need a winter jacket, hat and gloves at this time of year at the top of the mountain and sturdy footwear that could weather a snowfall in case it has snowed or is snowing when you arrive at the top! It can be quite cold at the top of Mount Washington. It is also possible that it will be very warm and lovely! Be prepared for anything!

Cog Railway Important Notes:

Tour buses and vans should drop off passengers at the Base Station's loading/unloading zone near the main entrance before parking in the designated Bus/RV lot. Whenever possible, the Group Sales Manager will meet your bus upon arrival.

The weather at the summit is unpredictable and is always considerably colder and windier than at the Base Station. In addition, the terrain beyond our boarding platforms and visitor center entrance is steep, rocky and difficult.

Your guests should be advised to bring warm clothes. You will need a winter jacket, hat and gloves at this time of year at the top of the mountain and sturdy footwear that could weather a snowfall in case it has snowed or is snowing when you arrive at the top! It can be quite cold at the top of Mount Washington. It is also possible that it will be very warm and lovely! Be prepared for anything!

Guests should be advised not to venture beyond the immediate summit area.

Note: This property has porta-potties only after Columbus Day weekend.

COG INFORMATION FOR MOBILITY-IMPAIRED GUESTS: Marshfield Base Station is fully accessible, with restrooms in the main and lower lobbies and an elevator providing access to both levels. However, our passenger coaches are historic in design, with three steps up to the boarding deck, narrow aisles and doorways. **A mobility-impaired guest must be capable of transferring from their wheelchair- by themselves or with assistance from others in their group or the group leader- to their assigned seat on the coach.** If space is available, we will transport your folding wheelchair or walker on the train, or we can provide one of ours for your use at the summit. Due to space and weight limitations, we are not able to transport motorized wheelchairs.
