Credit Card payments will be accepted (MC/Visa/Discover). Credit Card Authorization forms are available at www.dogwoodeventservices.com and will be accepted by email or mailed entry. Credit Card payment must accompany an Official AKC Entry Form and will be charged an 8% service fee for processing.

You must waive the signature requirement for delivery services, if applicable.

Telephone entries, unsigned entries, and entries without fees cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form cannot be accepted.

Confirmation of entry will be sent via email if an email address is included on the entry form. Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on US accounts or with International Money Orders in US Funds.

Returned checks and invalid credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis. No refund for duplicate entries or for overpayments of less than \$5.00.

Refund of entries, less \$10 per trial, for bitches entered in Obedience or Rally that come in season after the closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Show Secretary by January 22, 2022.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email or telegram prior to close of entries.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors,

and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Best of Breed Competition

Non-Regular Classes - single dog entries

Note: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class, for Best of Breed competition. Note: Chapter 11, Section 8, of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males & spayed females may be entered in the Veteran Classes at independent specialty shows only.

Veteran 8-10 years - For Dogs or Bitches at least eight (8) years and under ten (10) years of age on the day of the show.

Veteran 10-12 years - For Dogs or Bitches at least ten (10) years and under twelve (12) years of age on the day of the show.

Veteran 12 years and older - For Dogs or Bitches at least twelve (12) years of age on the day of the show.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not exhibited in the National Owner-Handled Series by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition during the entire show. A current assistant is defined by anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend, however current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

REMEMBER TO CHECK THE OWNER-HANDLER ELIGIBLE BOX ON THE ENTRY FORM

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

Junior Showmanship Competition - NOT BEING OFFERED

Novice Junior - For boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate - For boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior - For boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior - For boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

Open Intermediate - For boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

Open Senior - For boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

Master - For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class, with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition counts as one win towards moving to Open.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767.

Sweepstakes

HANDLER: The handler of a Sweepstakes exhibit must be either the owner, co-owner, breeder or member of their immediate family as they are listed on file with the American Kennel Club as of the closing date for the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made. Immediate family is defined as husband, wife, mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter or legal domestic partner. Step children and legal wards are also included in this definition. In-laws and grandchildren are not considered to be immediate family members. No other individual may take the entry into the ring during judging or check-in. The following individuals are excluded from showing an exhibit in sweepstakes unless they are the sole owner registered with the AKC or co-own the entry with a member of their immediate family (as defined above) or a legal domestic partner:

- Any individual listed as an agent on any dog in any regular or non-regular class at this or any other show in the previous two years.
- Any individual with an Agent number including, but not limited to an AKC Registered Handler Number or Professional Handlers Association (PHA) number.

To avoid confusion or question, it is recommended that a photocopy of the registration certificate be included with the entry for a co-owned exhibit.

Requirements for Puppy Sweepstakes

Open to any purebred Golden Retriever, at least six (6) months of age and under eighteen (18) months of age on the day of the show, and which is entered in any of the regular classes at the Specialty Show (under the same event number) at which these Sweepstakes are held. AKC Champions of Record are not eligible. Entry fee is \$20.00.

Classification for Puppy Sweepstakes

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

Requirements for Veteran Sweepstakes

Open to any purebred Golden Retriever, eight (8) years of age and over on the day of the show, that is individually registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC) or Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). AKC and CKC Champions of Record and neutered or spayed Golden Retrievers are eligible. Entrants need not be entered in any other class. Entry fee is \$20.00.

Division of Entry Money as Prizes

Prize money for each Sweepstakes event will be determined from the total collected for that event, rounded to the nearest dollar.

Thirty-five (35) percent of the total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses.

The remainder of monies is to be divided in each class as follows.

Jump Height Order

Obedience and Rally classes will be run short-to-tall for the morning trials and tall-to-short for the afternoon trials. Exhibitors entering classes with jumps are required to include their dog's jump height on the entry form. Tall to short will be accomplished with reverse catalog order for all classes.

Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers with multiple dogs in the same class.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

These events are open to Golden Retrievers which have been registered with the American Kennel Club and are six (6) months of age or older or have an acceptable foreign registration number (subject to restrictions in Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows).

Obedience and Rally classes are open to dogs of all breeds which are six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season may not compete in Obedience or Rally.

The Golden Retriever Club of Greater St Louis will NOT be accepting Obedience or Rally entries for dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program, which includes All American/Mixed Breed dogs.

Transfer Information

Moveups/Transfers will be allowed according to AKC Regulations, provided that the written request is received at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Email notice is acceptable.

Notice to Exhibitors

The Event Center will be available to Conformation/Obedience/Rally exhibitors on Friday, January 21 from Noon - 6:00 pm.
There are NO night time security personnel on site. NO DOGS will be allowed to remain in the building overnight.
CRATING & GROOMING: Grooming and crating in designated areas only. Bathing of dogs limited to bathing area, located next to grooming area. No dogs allowed in bathrooms. No Ringside crating in the Great Hall with the exception of the Agility, Obedience and Rally Trials. NO CRATES MAY BE PLACED DIRECTLY ON THE FLOORING SURFACE IN THE GREAT HALL. THERE MUST BE PLASTIC OR A RUG UNDER THE CRATE. ALL GROOMING TABLES MUST HAVE RUBBER OR PLASTIC CAPS ON THE END OF THE LEGS OF THE TABLE. No cones are allowed inside building.
NO EX-PENS allowed on the blacktop, the grass around the Event Center or in the Event Center. This includes the Gateway Hall.
All dogs must be on-leash at Purina Farms at all times (except when crated or as required to be judged).
Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
Rabies Vaccination Certificate - Missouri requires you to have proof of current rabies vaccination with you. Tags are not accepted.
Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
No dogs wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows: "a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve to Fifteen Month Class at a show prior to judging, and except that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show."
Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors of their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
Obedience and Rally Trials - Entries for Golden Retrievers only will be accepted until closing; all other breed entries will be put on a waiting list. At closing entries from other breeds will be accepted into the trial in order of receipt until the limit is reached.
All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All prizes offered by the Golden Retriever Club of Greater St Louis are through the generosity of its members and friends.
All exhibitors MUST abide by the 15-minute unloading/loading parking time limit designated around the Event Center. All vehicles must leave their headlights on while unloading. NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED NEXT TO BUILDING OR IN ANY ROADWAY. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.
PARKING: Exhibitor and visitor parking will be located on blacktop parking lots in front of the Purina Event Center. Vehicles are limited to one parking space. 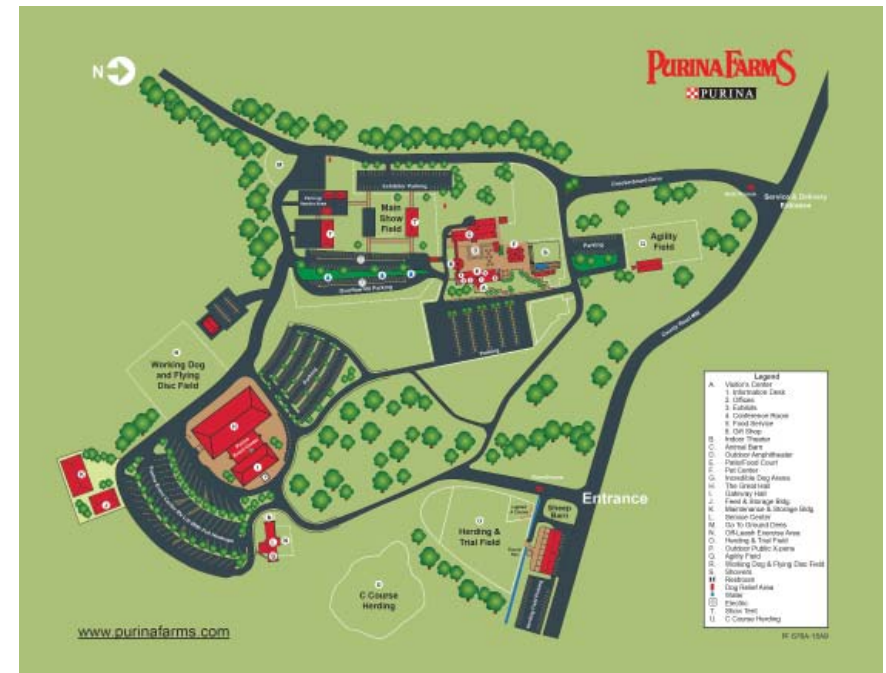
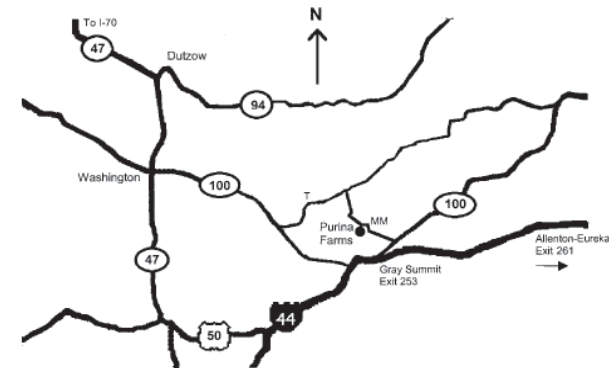
