- There will be GRCGSL members available to help with crating spaces to ensure everyone is space appropriately.

GROOMING MOVE-IN

- Grooming move-in Friday, January 21, 2022 from 8:00 6:00 pm
- Dryers will be allowed in the grooming area.
- Bathing is available on-site

COVID update from the club:

WHO SHOULD BE AT THE TRIAL?

- Due to COVID-19 restrictions, we ask that only exhibitors should be at the trial/specialty. We want to continue to have trials and must follow occupancy guidelines.
- While we have tried to make it so that everyone can stay in the building, if we need to, because of numbers in any
 one room, exhibitors will be asked to step outside if they are not running in the jump height/class that is currently
 running the course.
- Volunteers that are working classes can stay in the building

- There will not be self-serve awards. Ribbons will be prepared and displayed on the awards table. PLEASE be sure to social distance at the awards area. If you only want your sticker, just remove it from the ribbon, recycle the ribbon(s) to the recycle basket. Those ribbons will not be used again at this trial.
- NO outside food is allowed. The Checkerboard Café will be open for food and drink purchases.
- Please remember to wash hands frequently and please practice physical distancing.
- The Trial Committee has the right to amend these guidelines as needed to adhere to any changing COVID-19 guidelines or conditions. In the event we are unable to hold this trial due to changing state COVID-19 guidelines and need to cancel after the trial has closed, we will shred all checks.
