Extraordinary write-in opportunities (no candidate either party):

- Greenwood Township: Township Auditor (2 & 6 yr), Judge of Elections
- Madison Township: Township Auditor, Tax Collector
- Millville Borough: Member of Council (3 seats), Judge of Elections
- Millville Area School District: Millville School Director (3 seats)

Positions with no Democratic candidate on the ballot:

- **Greenwood Township:** Township Supervisor (6 & 2 yr), Tax Collector, Judge of Elections, Inspector of Elections
- Madison Township: Township Supervisor
- Pine Township: Township Auditor (2 & 6 yr), Judge of Elections, Inspector of Elections
- Millville: Mayor, Tax Collector, Inspector of Elections, School Director (4th seat)

*Write-In Campaigns: There are many open spots on the ballot! We need candidates for the 2-year term on the Bloomsburg Town Council, as well as for township supervisors, auditors, and tax collectors.

If there is not a Democrat running for a local nomination, we encourage you to run a write-in campaign by arranging for at least 10 supporters to write your name in on the primary ballot. (They all have to use the exact same wording for your name.) We can provide a full list of openings and assist with write-in campaigns!
