VOLUNTEER ROLES

Seniors and Reserves Football Timekeeper

4.5 hours per week

To work with an opposition club volunteer to keep time during games and maintain electronic scoreboard. The role can be split.

Reserves Umpire

2hrs per week (paid position)

Must gain umpiring accreditation prior to commencement (Club will arrange). If you are interested in learning to umpire, we can provide you with the resources to get you started.

Linemarking of Football Grounds

2 to 4 hours per week

Marking of lines on both grounds as required to meet schedule of games.

Training and support will be provided by club great Skip Carroll who is retiring after marking our grounds for the last 41 years.



Bar Service

Typically shifts of 2-3 hours at a time.

We will establish a roster of shifts throughout the year. You can offer your services weekly or at specific times throughout the season. The bar is open on Wednesday, Thursday and some Friday nights throughout the season, as well as Saturday afternoons for home games and some Saturday nights.

A Responsible Service of Alcohol certificate is required. MFNC will pay for training if you don't have an RSA already.

Merchandise Coordinator

2-3 hours per week during peak time coming into the season and the odd hours across the season

Coordinate the ordering of club apparel and merchandise, including liaising with suppliers on pricing, lead times and designs. Prepare proposals for new designs or styles to take to the MFNC Board. Ensure the Merchandise team is maintaining stock levels. Lead the advertising of merchandise on social media and other communication platforms.

Merchandise Crew

2 hours per week

We are looking for multiple team volunteers to limit the time required to be spent at the club fulfilling this role.

Assist in setting up for and selling merchandise on registration days, training nights and game days. Coordinate the distribution of uniforms to players in preseason, on training nights or game days.

Dinner Coordinators for Wednesday and Thursday night

4 hours per week

Responsible for coordinating the rostering of teams for service and cleanup. Posting the roster and meal choices to the relevant groups. Plan the weekly meals in advance and works closely with the Canteen Manager to organise and manage food delivery.
