



Scholarship Application

The Evergreen Music Studios Scholarship Program is based on two criteria. The primary consideration is the financial need of the student. The second consideration is the student's effort and desire to play piano or flute, which is strongly reviewed. Applicants must submit 4 items prior to being considered.

1. A short essay written by the applicant explaining why he/she desires to play the piano or flute.
2. A letter of recommendation from a teacher whom the applicant is already involved with in the music field.
3. A personal letter of recommendation from a non-family member.
4. The previous years tax return or equivalent proof of clear financial need.

Application for the scholarship and all items submitted will be treated confidentially. The expectations of students in the Evergreen Music Studios are high. The student receiving this scholarship is expected to exceed those expectations. Practice is a must. The student will have a very disciplined schedule for practicing. Five days a week of practice a is a minimum. Missed lessons will not be re-scheduled. The recipient of this scholarship will be expected to cover some of the instructional cost. That contribution will be determined on an individual basis and agreed upon prior to receiving the scholarship. This scholarship only helps cover the services supplied by the teacher. This scholarship does not cover supplies needed for the lessons. The student must still supply a working piano or flute, the required music, and their own transportation to and from lessons. This scholarship is not a guarantee of services from the Evergreen Music Studios, and/or David and Joanna Zagelow.
