(‘the registrant’)

To undertake ‘notifiable’ work with asbestos subject to the conditions below. The registration is granted from 1st January 2025 and shall remain valid until 31st of December 2027 unless revoked in writing by an authorised person.

Conditions

1. This registration document or a copy thereof, should be made available on request by the registrant for inspection by any person to whom the registrant submits a tender or quotation for work with asbestos and shall be available for inspection at all work sites.
2. The registrant shall give notice in writing of the work to the Health and Safety Executive at least 14 days before the work is commenced, or such other period as the authority will allow. Notice shall specify the type of work to be carried out, the likely duration of the work, the address of the premises at which the work is to be carried out and the date of commencement of the work activity. The enforcing authority must be informed in writing as soon as possible if this information changes. This condition will only apply to ‘Notifiable’ work with asbestos as defined Part 3 of the Control of Asbestos Approved Code of Practice 2013 (revised 2017) or any such update of said document, or when the registrant hires out employees (at operative level) to other registrants.
3. (a) Prior to submitting the notice of work required by Condition 2 the following documents shall be prepared by the registration holder?:
 - i. A suitable and sufficient written statement for the plan of work to be used.
 - ii. A suitable and sufficient written specification for the equipment for the protection and decontamination of those engaged in asbestos work and also for the protection of other persons, as appropriate to the work.
- (b) The registrant shall, on request by the HSE provide copies of the documents referred to in 3(a) and/or allow inspection of those documents as required.


