2025 AutoXtreme Event Rules

- 1. **All Participants are required to sign and complete** a) RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, b) SELF TECH INSPECTION and REGISTRATION FORM
- 2. **Vehicle Requirements** All vehicles MUST be street legal vehicles running on pump gas, with a valid registration, and proof of insurance to qualify for the event. Bolt on aftermarket parts are allowed and encouraged, however chassis, body swaps, and aero packages will be reviewed by the event staff. *See #11*
- 3. **Tire Rules** All Participant Classes must use commercially available, DOT approved, noncompetition, treaded (non-grooved) street tires (no competition radials, no R compound, drag radials or shaved tread) with a treadwear rating of 200 or higher. Tires must have a minimum of 2/32" tread depth at the start of the event and must not show excessive wear or abuse. The use of any type of chemical or nonchemical treatment is strictly prohibited.
- 4. A **two-second penalty** will be imposed for knocking a pylon over or out of its outline box. If the pylon is left standing and touching any part of its outlined box, it is not a penalty. Pointer or "laid down" cones are considered part of the track and will also incur a two-second penalty.
- 5. A **DNF penalty** will be imposed for any off-course excursions, failing to complete the course under your own power, and not coming to a complete stop after crossing the finish line. Stop pylons will be designated at a generous distance beyond the finish line. Crossing or contact with the stop pylons or any cones after the finish line is considered a violation and will result in a DNF penalty which will result in a 99.999 lap time.
- 6. Any vehicle that is driving in an unsafe manner, spins, loops or leaves the autocross course (2 or more wheels off) for any reason will be black flagged and required to report directly to the Timing Tent as soon as safely possible. The run will receive a DNF penalty. Multiple black flags issued to a participant will result in immediate dismissal from the event. Participants that drive unsafely or exhibit unsafe behavior during any segment of the event will be immediately disqualified and removed from the event.
- 7. A participant's official score for the event will be the lowest timed lap of the segment. The participant with the lowest timed lap in their respective class will be declared the daily class winner. In the event of a tie within a class, considering the second fastest run of each tied participant for each session, and so on until the tie is broken.
- 8. Seatbelts or safety harnesses must be installed correctly and worn properly during all segments of the event.
- 9. No open toe shoes or sandals/flip flops allowed.
- 10. **Helmets are Required** for all Drivers and any passengers during the AutoXtreme event. Helmets must have a SNELL rating SN2010 or newer.
- 11. The RacingByrds reserve the right to determine class eligibility of all participants in the event as well as all matters pertaining to the event. This could include assigning a participant as "Exhibition Only" or "Disqualification".
- 12. No "all electric vehicles" are able to participate in the 2025 AutoXtreme events.

- 13. **Class Definitions: All** vehicles will be categorized by DMV and insurance data. All vehicles must be registered and insured. Excessive weight reduction is not allowed and may result in reclassification.
 - a. Compact: 4cyl compact and sub-compact vehicles. No AWD vehicles will be allowed in this class and all vehicles must maintain a minimum of 95% of the original curb weight. Aftermarket upgrades, body kits, and aero packages are encouraged and must be SAFE for road use.
 - b. **Truck:** 1990 or older, full-size trucks, Blazers, Rancheros, El Caminos and must maintain a minimum weight of 3400lbs. Mini-Trucks will be handled at the discretion of the RacingByrds and must maintain a minimum of 95% of the original curb weight.
 - c. **Modern Muscle:** 1990 or newer RWD 4 passenger vehicles with a minimum weight of 3200lbs.
 - d. Classic Muscle: 1989 or older vehicles with a minimum weight of 3200lbs.
 - e. **Sprots Car:** 2 seat RWD vehicles with a minimum weight of 95% of the original curb weight.
 - f. **Super Car:** Light weight, AWD, rear engine, mid-engine, some front engine.
- 14. Event Access: Event access and Overnight camping is a privilege, and we ask everyone to respect the facility, security, and event staff. RacingByrds may, in its sole and absolute discretion, deny access to, or remove from the Premises or the Facility, any individual who: appears intoxicated; violates or threatens to violate any federal, state, county, or city law or Facility rule; unreasonably damages or threatens to damage any property at the Facility; engages in any activity that unreasonably endangers himself, others or their property; harasses, mistreats, abuses, injures, or threatens to harass, mistreat, abuse or injure any person at the Facility; or unreasonably fails to cooperate with Staff, or security personnel.
