LIABILITY RELEASE:

In consideration for Classic Equestrian Riding School and RideCERS, allowing myself or my child (if said participant is under the age of 18) to voluntarily participate in its activities, I agree as follows:

This agreement, waiver and release applies to Classic Equestrian Riding School, RideCERS, committees, employees, predecessors, successors, attorneys, insurers, members, and volunteers who are working in the course and scope of their duties on behalf of Classic Equestrian Riding School and RideCERS, at time of occurrence of any act or omission which is later alleged to be a cause or contribution to a claim for injury, damages, or death.

I forever release, hold harmless, and indemnify Released Parties (as defined above) from liability for any and all claims, demands, cause of action, damages, injuries or death to me, my minor child, my horse and leased Parties, whether known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, direct or indirect, arising out of participation in the past, present or future. Such activities to be included and not limited to equestrian activities, such as riding, use of or being near horses, whether the location be at an arena, stable or on a trail in association with Classic Equestrian Riding School and RideCERS.

I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF INJURY OR DEATH AS SET FORTH IN THIS RELEASE.

ACTIVITY RISK:

I understand that some Classic Equestrian Riding School and RideCERS activities take place in isolated or wilderness areas, over rough terrain, and/or trails of unknown condition and other activities take place on land or in facilities owned and managed by other owners from whom such land or facilities are

borrowed or rented. I understand that the organizers, workers, and members involved in Classic Equestrian Riding School and RideCERS are not always professionals in the horse industry or not professionals in planning or conducting of trips. I understand horseback riding is a rugged adventure recreational sport activity. I am aware that there are numerous inherent risks of serious injury, death or property damage to my horse or myself (my child). These risks are always present at Classic Equestrian Riding School and RideCERS. I understand that pregnant women are specifically advised not to ride horses.

NATURE OF HORSES:

I understand that no horse is completely safe and Released Parties make no representation or guarantees regarding the safety, training or suitability of any horse. Horses are 5 to 15 times larger, 20 to 40 times more powerful and 3 to 4 times faster than humans. If I fall from a horse to the ground, it will generally be at a distance of 4 to 6 feet, and the impact can and will injure me. A horse may divert from its training and act according to its natural survival instincts and may abruptly change directions, speed, trip, slip, fall, stop short, shift its weight, buck, rear, kick, bite, spook, or run from what it perceives to be danger, or if it is frightened or provoked. The above-mentioned things can also happen for no reason whatsoever.

CONDITION OF NATURE & LOCATION:

I agree that the Released Parties are not responsible for acts, occurrences or elements of nature of a particular location that can injure a person or scare a horse, cause a trip, fall or a reaction of some other manner. These elements include but are not limited to; thunder, lightning, rain, wind, wild and domestic animals, insects, loud noises, other people and horses which are subject to constant change in according to weather, temperature, natural and man-made objects. The Released Parties have not inspected and make no representation or warranties concerning safety or condition of any camping site, show grounds, trails, arenas and/or other visited locations.

HELMET WARNING:

I am aware that protective head gear which meets or exceeds the quality standards of the FEI certified and ASTM Standard F1163 equestrian helmet must be purchased and worn by me and/or my child while riding. The wearing of such helmet may reduce the severity of some head injuries and may prevent serious injury or death as a result of a fall or other occurrence.

CLASSIC EQUESTRIAN RIDING SCHOOL & RIDE CERS, LLC POLICIES

1. **ABSOLUTELY no smoking** anywhere on the premises! 2. **HELMET:** All riders must wear a riding helmet at all times when mounted. Helmets must be FEI & ASTM certified, and we also recommend riders purchase and wear a protective vest for jumping.
3. **FOOTWEAR:** Everyone on the premises, riders and observers, must wear appropriate footwear – **no open-toed shoes**. Riders must wear boots with a heel while in the saddle.
4. **LESSON CANCELLATIONS:** You must reach out to a RideCERS trainer with any lesson cancellations. Make-ups for cancelled lessons must be booked within 10 working days of the cancelled lesson, or they will be considered forfeit. Missed lessons without prior notice (no-shows) are **NOT** eligible for make-ups.
5. **PAYMENT:** Lesson payments are made to RideCERS by cash, check, or Venmo (@ridecers). Payments are due on the 7th of each month. A 10% late fee will be added to any payment not received by the 7th.
Board payments are made to Classic Equestrian Riding School by cash or check. Payments are due on the 7th of each month.
6. **RETURNED CHECKS:** There is a \$10 fee for a returned check.
7. **FEEDING HORSES:** Please ask a RideCERS trainer before feeding any horse that you do not own.
8. **GROUND SAFETY:** Horses can be dangerous, please always use caution. Do not leave small children unattended.
9. **PROFESSIONALISM:** As a representative of Classic Equestrian Riding School and RideCERS, all riders will conduct themselves in a mature and professional manner when they are on school grounds and away at shows. This includes but is not limited to dress code, behavior, and respect towards parents, trainers, RideCERS associates, other riders (from our barn and others), judges, and other show ground personnel.
10. **DRESS:** Riders are to dress appropriately for being at a barn. Anything you would wear to a party, don't wear here. Anything you don't want to get dirty, don't wear here.
11. **DOGS:** Please keep dogs on a leash at all times and keep them away from horses' legs and hooves. If your dog is nervous around horses, please leave them at home. We love our furry friends and don't want any injuries to them, our horses, or our riders.
