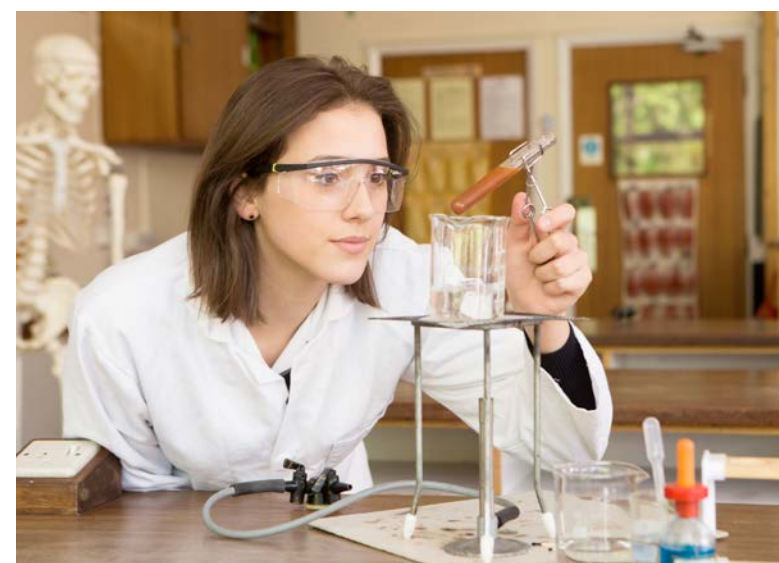
International students are welcome to join us in any year group from Year 7 to Year 12. We always encourage families to consider sending their children to study with us as early as possible as this gives girls the opportunity to get to know us, make friends and develop their English skills, before they get to the more serious examination years.

Throughout College, students are taught in small classes by excellent, committed teachers. Learning is stimulating and interactive and students are encouraged to think, learn and study independently.

Our students achieve excellent results in A level and GCSEs and over 75% typically receive offers from top Russell Group universities.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR LIFE BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

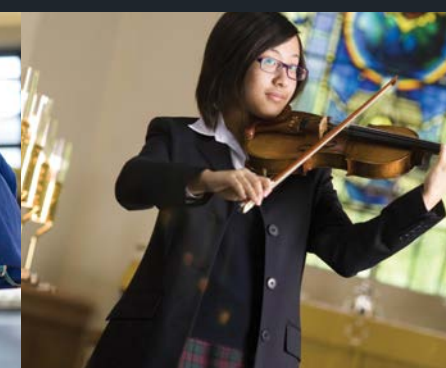
Life at College gives students the opportunity to excel outside the classroom in a broad range of specialist fields including sports, drama and music. We encourage all of our international students to take part in the wider opportunities that our school has to offer.



Performing Arts

We are a very musical school. We have a dedicated Music House, located in its own building, with more than 20 practice and rehearsal rooms. Our girls participate in a wide range of music groups including orchestras and string and wind ensembles. Our choir is widely regarded as one of the top school choirs in the UK and was a semi-finalist in the School Choir of the Year Competition.

There are also lots of opportunities for girls to participate in Drama through our annual productions and inter-house drama competitions, building their confidence.



Creative Arts

Our Art, Textiles and Photographic studios give girls the opportunity to explore and develop their creative skills. An annual trip to Venice provides much inspiration for the work of our Creative Arts departments. Many of our students go on to successful careers in the Arts and Fashion industries.

Sports for All

We have excellent sports facilities including a purpose built sports hall, extensive outdoor sports fields, netball courts, tennis courts and a 25m swimming pool. We play a range of competitive sports including netball, lacrosse, rounders, tennis, athletics and swimming and many of our girls compete at regional and national level.

Studying overseas means that our international students are often a long way from their homes and their families. That's why for us, boarding is centred on the concepts of "family" and "home". Our boarders live in traditional family homes; they have an extended family of boarding staff to care for and support them; and are surrounded by a wonderful array of boarding "sisters" of all ages.

We know that being away from home can be challenging for our girls, particularly to start with, but our experienced boarding staff are there to help and support them. Girls quickly make friends and settle into their home away from home.

When children study overseas it can be challenging for the parents, and our boarding staff are also there to support parents and keep them updated on their daughter's happiness and wellbeing.

Boarding at Harrogate Ladies' College is a unique life experience. It is a warm, nurturing, family environment which enables girls of all ages to build confidence, independence and lifelong friendships.

THE WEEKEND PROGRAMME A WORLD OF OPPORTUNITIES

Weekends at College are a really special and important time. They are a time when girls can try new things; visit new places; develop new skills; build confidence; and strengthen friendships.

We have a dedicated Weekend Programme. The choice of activities is wide: from cultural activities, to active experiences and social events. The programme is designed to give everyone the chance to try something new and exciting.

We also have a programme of more than 50 clubs and societies that run throughout the week in which our international students participate in. Throughout the year there are also extended trips available which enable girls to discover other parts of Europe such as Italy, France, Germany and Spain.

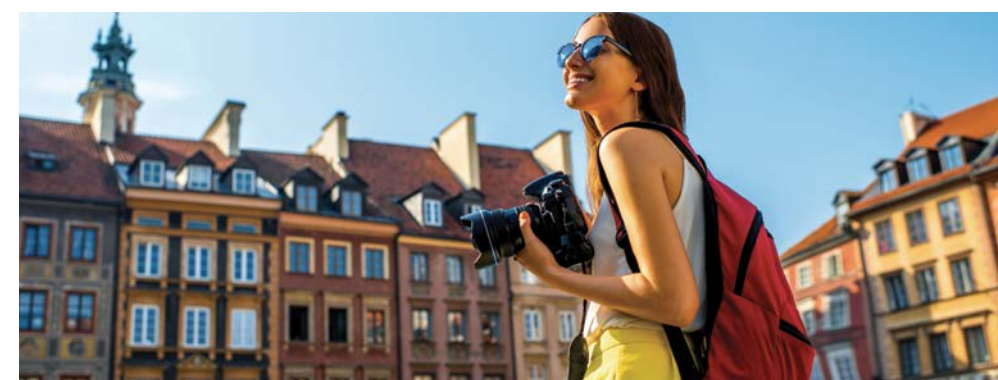

LIVING IN HARROGATE SAFE, **VIBRANT**, HAPPY...

HARROGATE - the “happiest place to live in the UK”

Harrogate is a safe, wealthy, cosmopolitan town with beautiful historic buildings and large open spaces and parks. It has a vibrant café culture and exclusive shops and boutiques – all of which our girls love! Our school is located in a quiet residential area just 5 minutes walk from the centre of Harrogate.

Harrogate is also a short train journey away from both Leeds (30 minutes), and York (40 minutes). Leeds is England's third largest city and a hub for business, shopping and culture, while York is one of the most famous historic cities in the UK.

Our nearest international airport is Leeds Bradford Airport (10 miles). Leeds Bradford operates direct flights to many European destinations and shuttle flights to London Heathrow (35 minutes), Paris (90 minutes) and Amsterdam (70 minutes) for fast and convenient connections to worldwide destinations.

Manchester airport is around 90 minutes' drive and operates direct flights to an array of European and worldwide destinations including Hong Kong, Beijing, Dubai, Moscow and Singapore.

Whichever airport you choose, we can arrange escorted travel within the UK between airport and school.
