protective, and soothing qualities, with no known drug interactions but caution advised for those with bee alleraies. Sunflower Lecithin helps skin retain moisture. supports barrier repair, and contributes to soft, wellhudrated skin. Eucaluptus and Rosemaru Oil provide refreshing scents, cooling or warming sensations, easing sore muscles and support circulation.

Palmitoulethanolamide (PEA, Palmidrol) was discovered by a famous neuroscientist in 1957. It has been used for nerve pain and flu sumptoms for almost 50 years in Europe. It is not as popular in the US. It works in our bodu as a messenger in cells to reduce pain and inflammation. Small amounts are produced in our bodu.

Does it contain marijuana (THC and CBD)?, NO! **Are there any side effects?** There should be no side effects at all.

Does it interfere with any other drugs I might be taking? It can affect some prescription drugs. If you are taking some blood thinners such as warfarin (Coumadin), you should tell your provider. PEA may affect cancer drugs, so you should discuss this with your provider.

Why do people like it? People like the fact that it works fast, is safe, and it does not cloud thinking like THC and some other oral prescription drugs like gabapentin and pregabalin that are often prescribed for nerve pain. PEA has multiple actions to reduce pain and inflammation: **PPAR-\alpha Activation**: Palmidrol activates the peroxisome proliferator-activated receptor-alpha (PPAR), a nuclear receptor that helps control inflammatory responses.

TRPV1 Receptor Modulation: Palmidrol interacts with transient receptor potential vanilloid 1 (TRPV1) channels which are involved in signaling pain.

Inhibition of Mast Cell Activation: Palmidrol reduces the activation of mast cells, which are immune cells that release inflammatoru substances.

Endocannabinoid System Interaction: Palmidrol inhibits the fatty acid amide hydrolase (FAAH) enzyme, which normally breaks down the endocannabinoid anandamide. This increases anandamide levels, contributing to its antiinflammatory and analgesic effects.

Neuroprotection: Some research suggests Palmidrol has protective effects on nerve cells, potentially guarding them against damage from inflammation and oxidative stress.

ADVERSE EFFECTS: PEA has been used orally for pain and inflammation in Europe for many years. Although rare, there are reports of allergic reactions, nausea and stomach upset. Drug interactions include warfarin as noted earlier, and potentially some drugs used for chemotherapy. It is recommended that providers be made aware of this. Topical use of PEA in Therapalm is less likely to have these effects.

"I have practiced pain medicine for 25 years. My first exposure to palmitoylethanolamide (which is now called PEA) was in the late 1990's, as I was treating patients with polyneuropathy, HIV and post-chemotherapy side effects. I had been reading some European articles about palmidrol (PEA), as it was called in Europe. I contacted the producer in the Netherlands about it. Unfortunately, because of concerns about abuse, which were unfounded, it was not available in the USA. I was, after makina inauiries, able to aet a compassionate waiver for some of my patients and found it to be effective in about 50% of patients with various types of neuropathies. It was over \$100 a month.

After considerable discussion, PEA was allowed to be sold in the USA in 2015 as a supplement. At that point, I began to tell patients about it and located a company that was a reasonable and reliable supplier. Since then, I have had more than 600 patients who have tried it as a capsule. Of these, slightly more than 50% have found it to be effective enough to continue using it. Oral dosages have varied from 350 mg twice daily to 700 mg three times daily, with a few taking more.
