Misc – Fairgrounds is behind on processing this year. Their website doesn't have our event on it yet. Shirley says that the contract has not yet been signed.

It was moved by Betty to have the Guild donate \$500 to Kim Zweigle and her family for the fire loss to their house. The motion passed.

Lynn Rogers, our new member, brought in samples of his stain glass work.
