This is when we elect a new board and choose our charities.** October is the meeting we discuss Winterfaire and see what we can change, if anything, for the better.

My only suggestion is if you don't attend meetings, then please don't complain.

Make sure your dues are paid. If dues are not paid by March 31 you will be dropped from the membership.

Craft Guild 1/29/19

Meeting was called to order at 6PM with Pledge of Allegiance led by President Shirley Williams.

Minutes for September, October and November were approved.

Treasurer's report –Based from online statements and statements in the mail. We have \$1,813.52 as of 1/14/19 at Tri Counties Bank. At the Credit Union (Golden 1 – secretary believes) we have \$184.89 in savings and the certificate has \$10,293.35, both of these are as of 12/31/18. We received \$153.38 in interest in 2018, mostly from the CD.

Shirley is the only person as signature on the account so far for both the bank and credit union.

The bank is waiting for the updated Secretary of State – Statement of Information (a corporate form that needs to be filled out when officers change as well as every 2 years, based on year of incorporation). Lorell was asked to fill it out, she sent it to Shirley to add a check for certification and copy of the page, she added the check and sent it to the State. As of the meeting, we had not yet received it back.

The bank also needs to have signature paperwork from the officers to update the account.

The credit union probably also needs this paperwork. We talked some about the CD which comes due in 2021. The credit union is in Folsom. We may pull the monies out early and deposit them in the bank.

We had a visitor Jack Smith who is a wood turner and showed off some beautiful spinning tops. He also joined as a member.

Membership – Susan McGuire – absent. Lori Murray our treasurer collected monies and applications. We will not accept money without an application, as everyone must have a new

application completed. The money was given to Shirley and Lori has the applications. Lorell has updated the roster for those that submitted money and applications at the meeting. We had 19 members sign up. See updated roster attached. **Note: If you are emailing anything to Susan, please note her new email address, as her prior email was hacked.**

It was decided to keep Winterfaire on the 3rd weekend in October. Motion by Dan Davis and seconded by Jim Brower.
