As a response to the \$10,000 limitation on State and Local Tax (SALT) that came with the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act, New York adopted substantive, comprehensive changes to the calculation of personal income taxes and real property taxes.

Creating a charitable reserve fund will significantly change the tax collection process at the local level. This seminar will provide an in-depth analysis of charitable reserve funds and address many practical questions about these changes.
