In April, we had a visitor, Coty Sparks, he is starting Little White Dove Ministry, a soon to be 501 c3 organization in which he reaches out to homeless, prays with people, hands out bibles, makes people aware of homeless centers and resources available for people with addictions. He is pictured with one of our volunteers and someone from one of the food pantries that we serve. When he came in the office to talk and find out



how to become a food pantry on our list of who we serve. We explained that there is an application process in which he fills out and Midwest Food Bank in Normal, Illinois would need to approve his food pantry. We explained that currently there is a waitlist of food pantries and that Midwest Food Bank decides when to add a new food pantry to our distributions

He knows first hand about addiction and homelessness and the resources available as he has personally risen up from the ashes and now is spreading God's word through his ministry. He went from the streets and through the addiction program and wants others to know that there is hope and to look to Jesus for that hope! We hope to be able to add some new food banks from our waitlist to our distribution in the future!
