We now serve 33 food pantries each month and helping them make a difference in the lives of the people of Eastern Kentucky! This month we received a large donation of fresh potatoes. 36 fifty pound



bags of potatoes were distributed to the food pantries in January. Another big donation was soup, each food pantry receives 20-30 cases of soup each month. Soup is such a blessing to the hungry people of Eastern Kentucky, it offers many options. It can be a meal or it can be used to create a meal.

We are so thankful to our partners that help us feed the hungry and help those in trouble in Eastern Kentucky. Each month we have many volunteers from Stanton Christian Church that help in the warehouse. We also receive help from Powell County Detention Center with loading the pallets of food. And we are always thankful for our partners that provide the food that we can distribute to the agencies. God is good all the time. All the time God is good!
