### Food, Drinks and More!

Have you ever gone to the cupboard and found it was empty? There are many Americans that are seeing this as costs of food, gas, utilities, and insurance are on the rise. When you look around and see what has happened with our economy doesn't it make you think if I am suffering this bad, than what is happening to those individuals and families in the poorest areas of our nation (Eastern Appalachia Kentucky)? This is an area that our ministry serves. This area lacks many resources and when there is a good resource to help this area it is important to help sustain it. This month we were able to do our Kentucky distribution in which we distributed 5,317 cases of food and drinks to 31 food pantries on July 15th and 16th! Our July 2nd distribution was packaged in Illinois and was distributed in Kentucky with 13 food pantries receiving 3,000 cases of food and drinks. Our July 15th and 16th distribution also included donated items, such as books, clothes, and household items that the food pantries could pick through to take back to their clients.
