INSTRUCTIONS FOR FACE/LID HYGIENE

X a day (at least every night to remove oils/allergens/eye makeup)

SHOWER- use a warm, wet washcloth- apply warm compress. Wash face, eyelids, eyebrows & rinse off

NO RINSE WIPES- wrap wipe around finger, clean upper & lower lid margins/lash-lines, use clean side each eye do not rinse off, dispose after each use (tip: cut wipes in 1/2 & tuck 1/2 back in pack to get 60 uses per box)

EYE MAKEUP REMOVERS- Use oil free cleanser (never leave eye makeup on overnight)
