The IAA, through its education and registered apprenticeship programs, has directly placed over 1300 successful graduates into full-time positions with its employer-partners, such as Allscripts, UVM Medical Center, Husky Injection Molding Systems, Vermont Information Processing, Triad Design Service, GE Healthcare, Dealer.com, Precyse Solutions (now nThrive), Hypertherm, Timken Aerospace, Vermont Precision Tools, Dartmouth-Hitchcock, and Clara Martin Center.

## **Our Programs**

Key features of IAA programs include:

- No-cost career training in an 8-10 week program (including books, laptops and supplies)
- Immediate guaranteed employment in a viable industry upon successful completion
- Potential for college credits upon successful completion (average 24 to 30)
- Stepped-up wage agreements through enrollment in a Registered Apprenticeship
- One year of continued On-the-Job Training with staff mentors
- Ongoing mentoring from IAA staff throughout training and Apprenticeship
- Potential for additional 39 college credits by the end of the one year Apprenticeship
- No prior education or experience required

## How to Apply

IAA programs are offered upon employer sponsorship of job openings. Once a program is announced, details and an online application will be available on our website:

- Step 1: Apply online at www.vthitec.org
- Step 2: Attend a mandatory Orientation session to learn more about the program, position and employer
- Step 3: Participate in aptitude assessments (no prior industry knowledge required)
- Step 4: Interview with program staff and instructors
- Step 5: Interview with sponsoring employer-partner
- Step 6: Program Enrollment for selected students
