


Gifts Into Fund by Calendar Year






1st Vice President Report

OCLC Board Meeting, June 16, 2021

Lions Sara Kitto and Nia MacKay have met with former and future Lion Sydney Allen, who generously willing to be our webmaster on Thursday, May 20th, 2021 at 4:30 to 5:30 PM. We discussed how to make our website more attractive, user friendly, 'organic' (evolves with ever changing activities), as well as well informed with what's on the District, MD-2, and LCI update.

Sport Extravaganza committee met twice on May 28th and June 8th, 2021 via Zoom confirming venues (Grand Prairie HS for goal ball tournament and Nimitz HS ISD for the rest) and dates October 22nd and 23rd, 2021. Both meeting was not attended by Region 10 personnel, but by many former R10 employees who are involved in this event since it started in 1997. This event was spearheaded by District 2-X1 leaders. A couple years later Region 10 agreed to collaboratively work with us to provide sport activities for VI and blinds students. I confirmed that our Club will donate (the same amount as we did in the past 12 years) and serve lunch again for all the attendance on Saturday. Next meeting is schedule for July 6, 2021. Please let me know if you are interested in volunteering for this committee.

On June 2nd, 2021 the second children eye exam program for students, a collaboration effort with One Community USA, held in Eladio Martinez Learning Center in Oak Cliff, Dallas. A total of 30 students were examined, several of them need to wear glasses full time. The clinic was volunteered by four LSTF board members, including Lion Charlene Vezina, and three others from our Club (Lions Kerry Goodwin, Sheryll McKay and Nia MacKay). Lion MacKay reported the event in our newsletter the Cub and the District newsletter the 'Link' for July edition.

The first adult eye clinic at North Dallas Shared Ministry since being cancelled due to COVID 1,5 years ago was held on Friday, June 11, 2021. At this debut eye clinic we've sponsored for so many years, there were 20 patients being referred, 18 were examined. The NDSM Executive Director Judy Rorrie stopped several times during the service, expressed her gratitude several for our service and, like us, was glad that we can serve people in need again. Besides four LSTF directors, this clinic was volunteered by Lions Charlene Vezina (LSTF Director and the new liaison for this clinic), Sheryll McKay and Nia MacKay. The next 2nd Friday of the month eye clinic will be held on Friday, July 16th, 2021 from 8 to noon. If you have any question about the eye clinic or you'd like to volunteer, **call** or **text** Lion Charlene Vezina at (817) 925-7292.

Club Service Chair Report

I spoke with a Brad Deason, Community Involvement Director of One Community USA, on June 2nd, 2021 at 9 AM, requested a meeting to expand our collaborative effort to Oak Cliff schools and, perhaps, to the Oak Cliff community at large. He's interested, we will discuss the venue and time soon (he's out on vacation until 3rd week of June).

All Club service activities, meetings, and programs have been recorded on MyLion and posted in Facebook. Remember, anything you do outside of our Club activities (example your volunteer time at your church) can be reported, since when you're out there, you are a Lion (a Lion is a leader) representing not only our Club, but also the LCI. Your activity report will be counted as our Club activity report. To do so, you have to report your activities to Club Service Chair.
