

### **Burton Gilliam, Actor**

While working as a fireman for the city of Dallas, Gilliam appeared in the role of "Floyd", the desk clerk, in the film *Paper Moon*. He then went on to appear in such popular movies as *Blazing Saddles* and *Back to the Future Part III*.

Gilliam also has had roles in movies such as Honeymoon in Vegas, Thunderbolt and Lightfoot, Fletch, Gator, Telefon, The Terror Within II and Farewell, My Lovely. His television appearances include Alice, Charlie's Angels, The A-Team, The Dukes of Hazzard and The Fall Guy, and he appeared as a regular on Evening Shade.

Before acting, Gilliam was a member of the Coast Guard's boxing team, where he won 201 out of 217 fights. He remained in the boxing world for decades, working as a referee in California.



Gilliam was born in Dallas and lives with his wife, Susan, in Allen, Texas. He has two children and four grandchildren. His granddaughter Hollie Vise is an American former world champion artistic gymnast. Gilliam graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School in 1956 and was inducted into the school's hall of fame in 2004. 


### Support LSTF. Win a Truck!


