

Rob Crain is a nationally recognized attorney representing individuals and families in catastrophic injury and death cases. He graduated from the University of Texas at Austin with High Honors and subsequently received his law degree from the University of Texas School of Law in 1994. He was recognized in 2004 by the Texas Young Lawyers Association as the Outstanding Young Lawyer of Texas. He is routinely recognized by his peers in state and national publications as one of the profession's best attorneys, including The American Lawyer's Best Lawyers in America, Texas Monthly's Top 100 Super Lawyers, and ALM's Top-Rated Lawyer in Texas.




Support LSTF. Win a Truck!
