#### Dr. Phil Berry, Jr.

Retired Orthopedic Surgeon, Methodist Dallas Medical Center

Dr. Phil Berry Jr. is celebrated for his expertise as an orthopedic surgeon, but his contributions to healthcare span more than 40 years. In 1971 he joined Methodist Dallas Medical Center, where he worked with colleagues to add a trauma care program—the second-oldest in Dallas County. He was also integral to the 1979 launch of CareFlite, a nonprofit air ambulance that expanded access to critical care and has serviced more than 110,000 patients.

During surgery in 1983, Dr. Berry was nicked with a surgical instrument and contracted hepatitis B. This condition controlled his life until 1986. He was placed on the Transplant List and waited an



agonizing six weeks, getting sicker and sicker. Then word came that it was his turn. A 30-year-old woman died from an aneurysm, and suddenly her liver became available to save Dr. Berry's life. He refers to her as his "Angel." He was back in the Operating Room only two months after the transplant, 36 years ago. In 1997, he helped launch an annual golf tournament that has raised nearly \$1 million for organ transplant recipients.

Dr. Berry was the 2019 honoree for the Oak Cliff Lions Club Bill Melton Humanitarian Award and has been a friend of our club for many years.


#### Support LSTF. Win a Truck!
