Lynda Wilbur has worked in the museum field for over two decades. At the Kimbell Art Museum, she designed and facilitated adult workshops, weekend family programs and school tours. After ten years at the Kimbell, Lynda Wilbur transitioned to the Nasher Sculpture Center where she managed the school tours and teacher workshops. Currently, Wilbur is the Manager of Access and Outreach Programs. In this role, Wilbur initiated and has grown the museum's accessibility programs for the neuro-diverse, blind, vision-impaired, adults with cognitive disabilities, and children with life-threatening medical conditions, in the quest of creating meaningful museum experiences.



Wilbur seeks to foster a person's love of art and sense of belonging whether at the Center or participating in a community event. She has published articles and is in the process of writing a book with colleagues. She has presented at state and national educational conferences. Wilbur earned both a Master of Arts and a Master of Education degrees from the University of North Texas. In 2019, she was honored with Southwest Airlines' Hospitality Champion Award for her exemplary museum work.

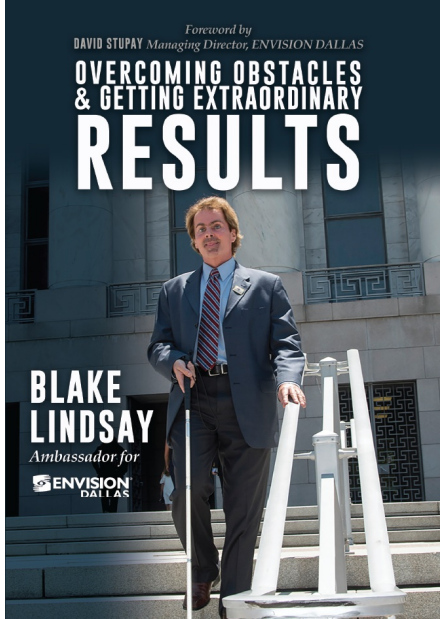
Buy Lion Blake's Book to Support OCLC
