Speaker – Sarah Wells Macias



Sarah Wells Macias and her sisters grew up on a farm in Plano – when there were still farms in Plano. Their father's passion was soil and water conservation. Their mother was a recognized and respected local historian. From these beginnings, Sarah went to Texas A&M and then Austin

where she worked for 25 years in parks and natural resource management.

Sensing that our relationship with God is reflected in our relationship with the land, this eventually led to Sarah's call to ministry. She earned a Master of Divinity from Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary and a Master of Sacred Theology from Drew Theological School in Madison, New Jersey. With an emphasis in studies on eco-theology and process philosophy, Sarah found her ministry call in regenerative farming. (God leads us in surprising directions sometimes!) From there she was ordained to the gospel ministry by Royal Lane Baptist Church. Sarah and her husband Rodney now live on Sister Grove Farm in Van Alstyne where they implement holistic grazing practices that increase biodiversity, improve the water cycle, and sequester carbon. Each of these acts of resilience give her hope as they work together towards mitigating climate change.

Rev. Macias serves on the Board of Creation Justice Ministries (formerly National Council of Churches Eco-Justice program). She is also President of the Frankford Cemetery Association in Dallas and a member of the City of Van Alstyne Library Board. Sarah and Rodney have two daughters, Mary Katherine and Jane. They both live in the Austin area and are public school teachers.

This future Lions Club had their first community service project by providing a spot vision screening and eye clinic at a Craft Fair, held at First Baptist Church of Fate.

Lions Charlene Vezina, PDG Darla Wisdom, Sheryll McKay, Vitaly Lunev and Nia MacKay volunteered at the spot vision and the acuity screenings. The spot vision screening was done primarily for children under 13 years, the acuity screening was givin to children (over 13 years old). A total of 20 people being spot screened (in the church's day care room) and 16 people got eye refraction and screened by an optometrist on the Neil Roach Eye Clinic Bus. The screenings are free, those who will need eyeglasses were charged \$10 fee. 100% of the collected fees were donated to the church.

PDG Wayne Meachum and Lions Ted Ferguson-who initiated the sponsorship and formation of the Fate LC, Suzanne Duvall and 1st Vice District Governor Fred Conger attended the event. Lions Anisa and Mickey who came at a later time due to their other commitments were able to look and shop around the Fair, as well as got a chance to be in the pictures.




