He spent the career in banking first two years with Wells Fargo Commercial Mortgage in San Francisco followed by 10 years in Dallas with Prudential Financials' PGIM Real Estate, the second largest real estate asset manager in the world. Over his career he has been involved in some of the most prolific real estate deals, including loan work outs for the largest ever apartment loan as well as the largest securitized hospital loan, overseeing credit risk assessment of the largest hospital lender and production of low-income housing utilizing tax credits.
