Getting Along With the Other Side

Former local party chairs Hon. Rodney Anderson and Hon. Carol Donovan will share stories and discuss ways they were able to work together to conduct the Dallas County elections while still representing their respective parties. Former Farmer Branch Mayor Hon. John Dodd will moderate the program.





As mayor of Farmers Branch from 1982 to 1988, Farmers Branch was listed as a Top 10 Cities. President Reagan appointed PP John as an advisor on city issue and offered him a Presidential appointment. Governor Ann Richards appointed him as chair of a special commission on saving and loan crisis in 1987. This a small partial list of Lion John's community involvement. He has been member of the Oak Cliff Lions CLub since 1987 (35 years).

Rodney Anderson is an American politician and businessman who served three terms as a member of the Texas House of Representatives from 2015 to 2019, representing the 105th district, and from 2011 to 2013, representing the 106th district. From 2019 to 2021, he served as Dallas County Republican Party Chairman.

Rodney has been in the title insurance industry since 1993 in various capacities. He currently serves as Executive Vice-President of Alliant National Title. He is also the firm's National Agency Manager and manages sales operations for 38 states.

In 1990, Anderson earned a Bachelor of Business Administration in Real Estate from the University of Texas at Arlington. Anderson is a lifelong resident of Dallas County. He is a member of the Grand Prairie Rotary Club. He has been married to Heather Anderson for 30 years and they have three children.

PP Carol Donovan is a native of Dallas, an attorney-mediator, and a former Dallas County Democratic Party Chair (June 2015-June 2021). She has a JD, a Certificate in Nonprofit Leadership, and is credentialed as a Texas Mediator. She has practiced law in Dallas for over 40 years with an emphasis on mediation and probate law since 1993.

In both her profession and her community work, Lion Carol works to resolve disputes and facilitate communication. In addition to practicing law, she has served as a nonprofit executive, community volunteer and public speaker. She is a member of the Oak Cliff Lions Club since 1993 (29 years). However, her favorite role is as grandmother to her three "almost perfect" grandkids.
