Food as Medicine: How I'm Curing MS with Diet

In September 2003, Michelle was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis after falling out of bed with no feeling in her legs. In February 2019, she had been on four different disease-modifying drug treatments but was experiencing severe progression in the disease. She was losing vision in both eyes from progressive optic nerve damage and was unable to walk more than 10 feet without risk of falling and used motorized carts and scooters when a lot of walking would be required.

Her long-time friend, Past President Lion Iris Smith grabbed her by the shoulders at a Lions Club meeting and told her about a diet protocol she had seen and told her, "you have to get this book and try this!" Michelle bought the book that night and started the new protocol immediately. Two weeks later, the vision improved in



her right eye to be able to read using it, and her mobility began to improve rapidly. Since then, she has been snow skiing three times and no longer needs any motorized vehicle to get around. She also eliminated all prescription medications in 2021 and will share why this diet protocol has been so miraculous.

Even if you do not have a chronic disease like MS, you will learn ways to improve your overall health.




Support LSTF. Win a Truck!
