The Kemmerer Senior Center provides curb to curb around the town transportation. Participants must be able to navigate from the curb into the van when using assistive equipment with minimal assistance. If a wheelchair rider is unable to load at the curb for any reason and/or refuses to ride the wheelchair lift the participant may be denied service.

Participants are encouraged to travel with a personal assistant capable of assisting with transfers if assistance is considered necessary for the safety of the patron. The personal assistant will not be charged a transportation fee as per WYDOT.
