KEEP YOUR HOME WARM THIS WINTER



REDUCE YOUR WINTER HEATING BILLS

LIEAP's Seasonal Heating Assistance covers a portion of your monthly heating bills for natural gas, electricity, propane, coal, wood, and other fuel types. The amount awarded is based on your energy needs, income, and family size. The application period is Oct. 1, 2025 - April 30, 2026.

RECEIVE HELP WITH HEATING EMERGENCIES

LIEAP's Crisis Intervention and Prevention Assistance helps households address crisis situations like utility deposits, utility disconnect/shut-off notices, broken furnaces, or running out of fuel. This assistance is available through April 30, 2026.

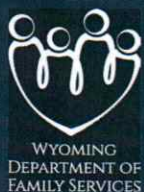
IMPROVE YOUR HOME'S ENERGY EFFICIENCY

The Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) helps improve your home's energy efficiency through insulation, sealing leaks, and other measures. Assistance is determined using different income guidelines than LIEAP (visit lieapwyo.org). Available year round.

Worried about rising heating costs? LIEAP might be able to help, especially if you are 60+, have children 5 and under, or are disabled.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- ✓ Wyoming residents
- ✓ Households with an income up to 60% of the state median income level (See the table below.)
- ✓ Homeowners or renters, including if you live in an RV or camper that is permanently parked

SIMPLE STEPS TO APPLY

STEP 1: PREPARE YOUR DOCUMENTS.

- Contact information (name and email). Your email will be used to access your application and to receive information from LIEAP.
- Proof of identification (Examples: driver's license, birth certificate).
- Proof of income for all household members.
- Most recent heating and electric bills (showing name, account number, and service address).
- Rental verification, if applicable.

STEP 2: REGISTER ONLINE AT LIEAPWYO.ORG OR CALL (800) 246-4221.

Create an account by providing your name and email. Your email is your username.

STEP 3: COMPLETE YOUR APPLICATION.

Select the program(s) you're applying for. Accurately fill in your details and upload the required documents.

STEP 4: REVIEW & SUBMIT.

Make sure all information is correct. Click "Submit" to send in your application.

STEP 5: TRACK YOUR APPLICATION.

Use your dashboard to check application status, payments, and more. Federal guidelines allow 45 days from the date that LIEAP receives the application to process your application. Crisis applications are processed more quickly.
