We provide <u>curb to curb</u> around the town transportation daily Monday through Friday between **9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.** We will do our best to accommodate transportation needs outside of the specified hours with advance notice. If you depend on the senior bus for transportation, please keep this in mind when scheduling appointments. **We do not offer out of town transportation.**



Kemmerer Senior Center transportation participants must be able to navigate from their wheelchair into the van with minimal assistance if they choose not to ride the wheelchair lift. Our staff is trained for public transport and the driver is unable to assist with mobility impairments during transfers. Participants are encouraged to travel with a personal assistant who is capable of assisting transfers if assistance is needed. The personal assistant will not be charged a transportation fee as per WYDOT.


