



WAKE UP - CLARION CALL

*Seek the LORD while He may be found;
call on Him while He is near. Isaiah 55:6*

The Lion of the tribe of Judah is roaring over the Body of Christ. He is roaring over your personal circumstances. He is roaring over your heart and mind. He is roaring over YOU. Jesus Christ is standing at your door – will you let Him in to dine with you?

*Then one of the elders said to me, "Do not weep!
See, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has
triumphed. He is able to open the scroll and its seven seals."
(Revelation 5:5)*

*"Look! I stand at the door and knock. If you hear my voice and
open the door, I will come in, and we will share a meal together as friends. (Revelation 3:20)*

Everything as we know it is about to change.

When people are saying, "Everything is peaceful and secure," then disaster will fall on them as suddenly as a pregnant woman's labour pains begin. And there will be no escape. (1 Thessalonians 5.3)

Jesus is returning for His spotless bride (Ephesians 5.27). Lukewarmness will no longer be tolerated in the hearts of believers. There is coming a time when God will separate the sheep and the goats (Matthew 25:31-33). God in his love and mercy is saying now is the time to **WAKE UP SLEEPER**.

Living in the Light

Imitate God, therefore, in everything you do, because you are his dear children. Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ. He loved us and offered himself as a sacrifice for us, a pleasing aroma to God.

Let there be no sexual immorality, impurity, or greed among you. Such sins have no place among God's people. Obscene stories, foolish talk, and coarse jokes—these are not for you. Instead, let there be thankfulness to God. You can be sure that no immoral, impure, or greedy person will inherit the Kingdom of Christ and of God. For a greedy person is an idolater, worshiping the things of this world.

Don't be fooled by those who try to excuse these sins, for the anger of God will fall on all who disobey him. Don't participate in the things these people do. For once you were full of darkness, but now you have light from the Lord. So live as people of light! For this light within you produces only what is good and right and true.

Carefully determine what pleases the Lord. Take no part in the worthless deeds of evil and darkness; instead, expose them. It is shameful even to talk about the things that ungodly people do in secret. But their evil intentions will be exposed when the light shines on them, for the light makes everything visible. This is why it is said,

*“Awake, O sleeper,
rise up from the dead,
and Christ will give you light.”*

Living by the Spirit's Power

So be careful how you live. Don't live like fools, but like those who are wise. Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days. Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do. Don't be drunk with wine, because that will ruin your life. Instead, be filled with the Holy Spirit, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs among yourselves, and making music to the Lord in your hearts. And give thanks for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Ephesians 5:1-20

I was shown a picture of a high fence. On one side of the fence was the Kingdom of God. It was all light because He is the light of the world and whoever follows Him will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life. We are children of the light and the day. We are awake and watchful for the day of our salvation is nearer now than we first believed.

For you are all children of the light and of the day; we don't belong to darkness and night. So be on your guard, not asleep like the others. Stay alert and be clearheaded. Night is the time when people sleep and drinkers get drunk. But let us who live in the light be clearheaded, protected by the armor of faith and love, and wearing as our helmet the confidence of our salvation.

For God chose to save us through our Lord Jesus Christ, not to pour out his anger on us. Christ died for us so that, whether we are dead or alive when he returns, we can live with him forever. So encourage each other and build each other up, just as you are already doing. (1 Thessalonians 5:5-11)

When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.” (John 8:12)

On the other side of the fence was complete darkness. I hear the Lion of the tribe of Judah, Jesus Christ, roar. In the picture I saw people were sitting on the fence. You are either all in or all out. Jesus will not tolerate a lukewarm bride. In Revelation 3:14-16, Jesus said how I wish you were either hot or cold but because you are neither I will vomit you out of my mouth. *“These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: “I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot. So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth.*

Jesus told us He is coming soon, and His reward is with Him. *"Look, I am coming soon, bringing my reward with me to repay all people according to their deeds. (Revelation 22:12)*

Choose **TODAY** whom you will serve.

But if you refuse to serve the LORD, then choose today whom you will serve. Would you prefer the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates? Or will it be the gods of the Amorites in whose land you now live? But as for me and my family, we will serve the LORD." (Joshua 24:15)

This is all the more urgent, for you know how late it is; time is running out. Wake up, for our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed. The night is almost gone; the day of salvation will soon be here. So remove your dark deeds like dirty clothes, and put on the shining armor of right living. Because we belong to the day, we must live decent lives for all to see. Don't participate in the darkness of wild parties and drunkenness, or in sexual promiscuity and immoral living, or in quarrelling and jealousy. Instead, clothe yourself with the presence of the Lord Jesus Christ. And don't let yourself think about ways to indulge your evil desires. (Romans 13:11-14)

Would you like to have a personal relationship with the true living God, belong to the family of God and receive eternal life and salvation through faith in Jesus Christ?

Pray this prayer out loud:

Heavenly Father, I come to You in the Name of Jesus. Your Word says, "Whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved" (Acts 2:21).

I am calling on You Lord. I pray and ask you Jesus to come into my heart and be Lord over my life according to Romans 10:9-10: If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved.

I do that now. I confess that Jesus is Lord and I believe in my heart that God raised Him from the dead. I repent of all my sins God. Wash me, cleanse me, create in me a pure heart that I may live for you all the days of my life. I am saved. I am a child of God. I live in the light and will never walk in darkness. My sins are forgiven and I am forever united to you. Thank you Jesus. Amen

Praise God you now belong to the family of God, and you are His child. Welcome to the light.

Walking in the Light

And this is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you: God is light, and in Him there is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with Him yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say we have not sinned, we make Him out to be a liar, and His word is not in us.

Acts 2:21

And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.

Romans 10:9-10

If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Titus 3:5

He saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit.
