The Gateway Championship Finals format will be run in a finals-only format. Running events will be run in heats against time (slowest to fastest) and horizontal field events will have 4 attempts only. UNF will run a 9 lane meet.

Entries – due by 11:59 p.m. Tuesday 4/8/25

- The Gateway Conference Meet has been posted on Direct Athletics, and you may begin registering your athletes at this time. Once it closes it will not be reopened.
- Limit of 3 entries per individual event unless 4th entry meets minimum qualifying mark. If your athletes does not have 4 qualifying marks in Gateway Meets, they will not be able to compete in the Gateway Conference Track Championship. Times will be verified.

Important Information

- Tickets will be \$12.00. UNF will provide details for tickets.
- Parking will be in Lot 18.
- All athletes stay outside. Team areas will be located in Tent City. (See map below)
- No food deliveries are allowed, and athletes are not permitted to leave campus while school is still in session.
- Athletes are not permitted on the infield. Warm up area will be located on practice track. (See map below)
