Sri C.K. Bhardwaj, Advocate has filed Vakalatnama on behalf of the petitioner no. 1 (Km. Chanchal) corpus today be kept on record.

Heard Sri C.K. Bhardwaj, learned counsel for the petitioner no.1 and learned AGA of the State.

Pursuant to the order dated 9.8.2010, the corpus ( Km. Chanchal) petitioner no. 1 appeared before this Court. She was identified by Sri Aklank Jain, learned counsel for the petitioner no. 2 as well as by her counsel Sri C.K. Bhardwaj. Upon inquiry, she informed the Court that she is legally wedded wife of Rahul @ Tony-respondent no. 4 and she was living with him on her own accord without any pressure or compulsion. She further informed the court that she has not been illegally detained by the respondent no. 4, her husband against her wish. She further informed the court that she wanted to live with her husband respondent no. 4 Rahul @ Tony.

From the appearance as well as from the material brought on record, the corpus appears to be major. Thus, she is free to go wherever she desires.

There being no illegal detention, the habeas corpus petition fails and is dismissed.
