PRE-KINDER CLASS

The primary goal of our Pre-Kinder program is to prepare every child for Kindergarten while sharing the Bible. Our curriculum is Bible-based and focuses on preparing the children with fine motor skill development, pre-reading skills, math, social studies, science and art. Our staff also works on the development of key socialization skills which are vital to a successful Kindergarten experience.

Our program includes evaluations that are conducted at the beginning of the year, as well as a follow up at the end of the year. The areas assessed include:

- Physical Development focusing on gross and fine motor skills
- Social and emotional development focusing on self-concept and play behavior
- Intellectual Development with Cognitive reasoning and thinking, numerical concepts and creativity
- Language and communication with biblical concepts
