Executive Board Meeting

Southwood Shores POA Park

Southwood Shores POA Board met in Executive Session on October 1, 2022, at 3:00 PM.

The meeting was called to order by President Wicked Miller.

The following Board Members were in attendance: President Glen Miller, Vice President Jim White, Treasurer Mark Wiesmann, Board Member Glenn Howell

The following Board Members were absent: Secretary Edna Maxwell, Board Member Christi Hanson, Board Member April Adkisson.

The following agenda items were discussed:

- 1. Board members discussed limiting liability exposure at our park/boat ramp and how to make it as safe as possible.
- 2. Conditions and upkeep on several properties in the neighborhood was discussed. Efforts will be made to contact some of these homeowners. The Trash Bash efforts were also acknowledged.
- 3. Treasurer Mark Wiesmann updated the group on the amount of funds available to the Association. He proudly announced that over \$1,200 in donations were received from generous Southwood Shores property owners in the past month.
- 4. Our new attorney, Aubrey Jones from Athens, was discussed. After we submitted documentation to an attorney in Tyler, we waited for 30 days and did not get a response. We have provided copies of Southwood Shores Deed Restrictions dated May 20, 1992, our Southwood Shores By-laws dated March 15, 1986, and our Articles of Incorporation for Southwood Shores dated November 6, 1984, to Mr. Jones.

- 5. The Board discussed several questions to ask the attorney to chart our path forward as a property owner's association. These questions will be submitted in the next week.
- 6. A timetable for updating our bylaws was discussed. Creating a "Bylaw Committee" was also discussed. Vice President Jim White will start the process, we will get legal advice on the process with a goal of completing them hopefully by year end.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:15 pm.
