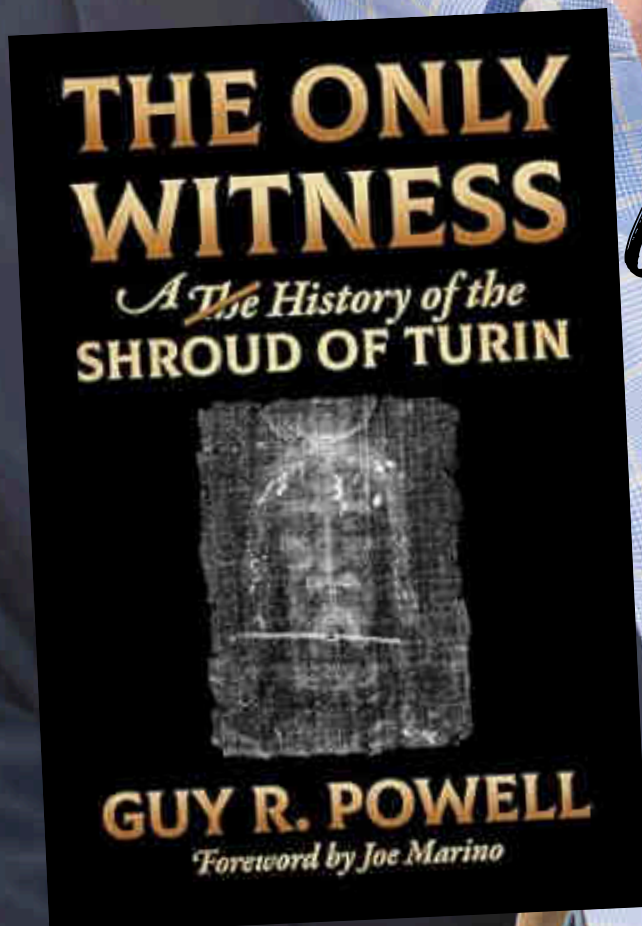

If you're interested in a Christian story intertwined with a possible history of the Shroud then this story, *The Only Witness* will be of special interest to you.

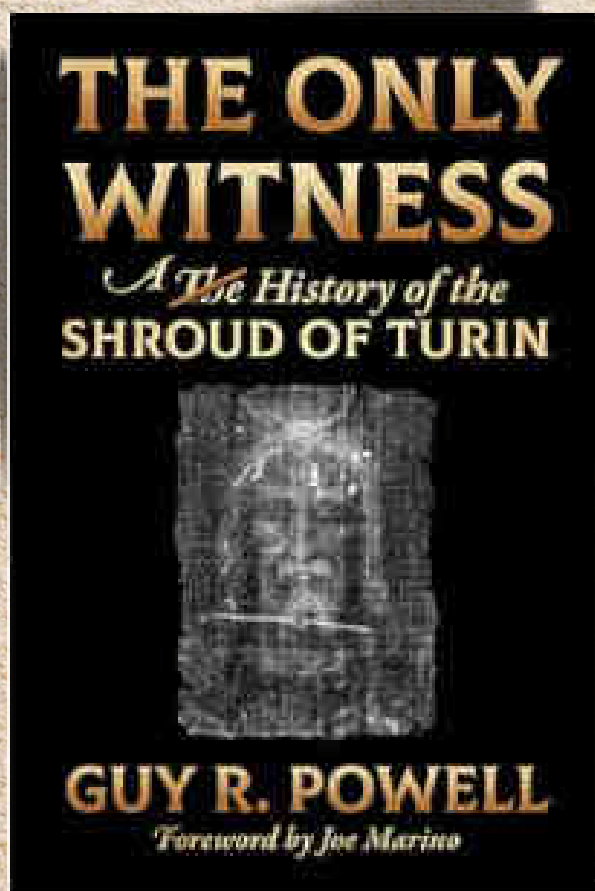

Keith Joseph Bennett, is a New York-based 8th-degree black belt who has been practicing martial arts (Tang Soo Do) for almost 50 years and operating Keith Bennett's Karate Academy for decades. Bennett, 65, is a prostate cancer survivor, and still trains faithfully every day.

He overcame many challenges in life, including childhood poverty, abuse at the hands of his stepfather, broken marriages and financial losses. In 1994, he lost everything after the local IBM plant closed in Kingston, N.Y.

Bennett, an Army veteran and longtime philanthropist in the Kingston area, just released a book called "Do You See: Living by Faith," an autobiography published by Mermaid Publishers, that is a painfully honest look back on his rough childhood and the journey he embarked on to rebuild his life.

Of course, he goes into all the details about when he began training in the martial arts and starting his karate school in Kingston. It's been around since 1990 and has experienced ups and downs, particularly "downs" after IBM closed and then again during the pandemic.

Bennett is not shy about sharing how his faith in God carried him through the dark days. He masterfully weaves it into the book and points out how it grounded him and gave him purpose to push on.

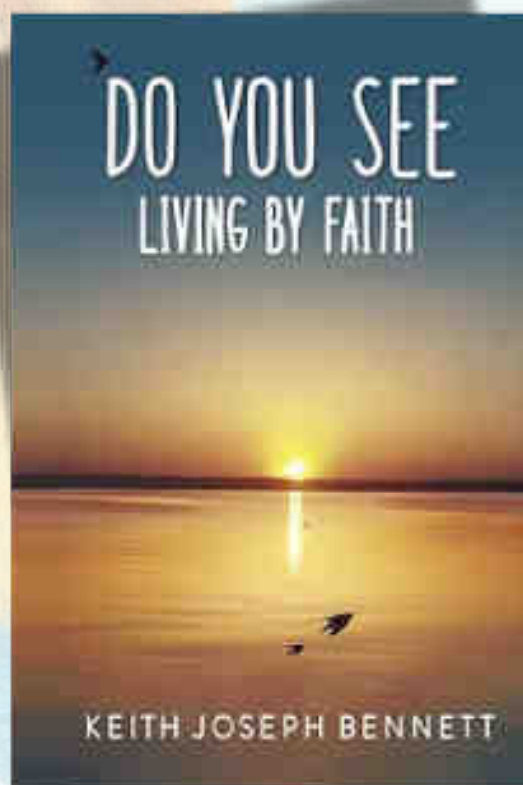
Bennett, a Rochester, N.Y. native, has been studying martial arts since 1976. The Army veteran opened his first school on Albany Avenue in Kingston in September 1990. In the book, he says it became an overnight success and was regarded as one of the biggest schools in the country. During this time, Bennett earned international recognition, rubbing elbows with celebrities, training with the best practitioners and traveling the world to open karate studios.

In "Do You See," Bennett recalls how he lost everything—his house, his cars and even his wife—after the IBM plant closed and enrollment at his academy plummeted from 400 students to 65. He calls it his "fall from financial grace" and says he "went from hero to zero and felt broken and alone."

CONVERSATIONS WITH MY PASTOR-"HOLY SPIRIT" (First Session)

"Hello, pastor. Thanks for seeing me."

"Of course," pastor said with a welcoming smile. "I'm always here to support the folks in my Church. What can I do for you?"

"I have an issue with the Church that I need to get off my chest. Actually, there are two issues involved that relate to the same subject."

"Go on. I'm listening." His smile turned into a noncommittal slash across his face.

"I don't think the Church correctly understands the nature of God. Specifically, the Godhead."

"That's a suspiciously big issue!" His mouth turned downward into a frown. "Are you sure you're on the right track? I wouldn't expect a lay person to be concerned about theological matters. You realize, don't you, that our understanding of God has been settled for well over a millennium. This would be a bad time to try and change things, particularly since there are too many Churches that are going off the rails these days, sliding down a slippery slope. I hope you're not down on Paul. He told us that Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever. Look it up. It's in Hebrews 13:8."

"I don't have anything to say against that. I don't have any issue with Scripture itself, provided that we're talking about the original manuscript. But in one very important area, I believe that the original Scripture was tampered with."

"Actually, I have a question of my own. Do you have a degree from an accredited seminary?"

"Well, no, but. . ."

"Have you even attended a seminary?"

"No, but. . ."

"I'll listen to you, but you should know that I'm doing so out of politeness to a member of my congregation. So what is it you wish to say?" He looked down at his watch.

"I question the Church's understanding of the composition, roles and characters of the three Members of the Trinity."



“How so?”

“In just about every expression of the Christian faith, including both Catholic and Protestant versions, the Holy Spirit is seen as weakly masculine, causing confusion on the various roles attached to each Member of the Godhead, destroying its essence as Family, and violating Moses’ Shema in Deuteronomy 6 that our Trinitarian Godhead is one God. Besides that, the present arrangement weakens the love between God and man.”

“Are you trying to suggest that the Holy Spirit is feminine? I have to tell you, there’s a movement within the fallen Church that tries to claim that God is a woman. Is that what you’re trying to say? If you are, that’s blasphemy.”

“No, I’m not saying that. The Father and Son are masculine, more strongly so than the present arrangement suggests. I’m fully in agreement with the Bible there. In fact, I take to heart what Moses said in Deuteronomy 23:1 and what Paul said in 1 Corinthians 6:9 and 10 about weak masculinity:

“He who is wounded in the stones, or hath his privy member cut off, shall not enter into the congregation of the Lord.”

“Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolators, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.”

“These Scriptural statements effectively take the dual-gender idea of individuals off the table as well. Both Jesus and the divine Father must be strongly and exclusively male. But the Holy Spirit, one of the three, must be female. With that understanding, everything falls into place: the Family nature of the Godhead emphasizes the singularity of God. The Trinitarian nature becomes subordinate to the oneness of Family, allowing the threeness of God to shine in the individual Members of the Godhead, who now possess distinct roles. God the Father is the Will behind Creation; the Holy Spirit is the Means to transform the initiating concepts into reality; and the Son is the Reality itself. Notice in this that the divine Means, following the conceptualization created by the Will, gives birth to the Reality. Simple but profound.”

“But then, why would the Church have been so misguided for so long if what you say is true? I find it hard to believe that such a gross misrepresentation of God as you claim would persist for so very long. The slope into godlessness is becoming steeper, and now you want to give Christianity a big push over the cliff.”



“I don’t find it hard to believe, and just maybe a correct concept of the Holy Spirit would pull Christians away from the cliff instead of pushing them over. By this time, nobody can remember how the misrepresentation came about, so we no longer have the means to challenge the original thinking. But we can make an educated guess. To me it’s obvious. If you read and understand the mindset of the Church Fathers around the time when Constantine legitimized Christianity and the Church held the convention at Nicea, there was a lot of arguing going on about what belonged in Scripture and what didn’t. It got pretty heated, as there were some popular notions that were later considered to be heretic, and there was also the question about which of the many fragments relating to God available at the time should legitimately be included in the canon of Scripture. Another huge issue at the time was the desire of the Church, a Body that was just coming out of severe persecution, to make a distinction between the Church and the degenerate secular society that surrounded them.

The sexual debauchery of the Roman society went way beyond the bounds of proper behavior, and gave the Church the strong desire to separate herself from the prevailing low standards.”

“I’m not so sure that you’re on a tenable path” pastor said with a dismissive shake of his head. “It’s a lot to swallow. I’ll give some thought to the matter and get back with you.”

Pastor entered the restaurant with an ebullient smirk. His smile broadened as he sat down on the opposite side of the table.

"I've done some thinking about our talk last week, he said. It turns out that we really don't have an issue here. After all, most Church goers understand our God to have a Trinitarian nature, regardless of a gender issue. That's the real issue, right?"

"I hate to burst your bubble, pastor, but a recent survey of supposedly committed Christians found that only 24 percent of them believed in the Trinity.

And of those who did believe in the Trinity, I wonder how many of them adhere to the heresies of modalism or its opposite, tritheism. I respect you, pastor. You deliver good sermons, and I know you don't take God lightly. But think of how much more effective you could be if you truly understood who God really is."

"Whoa there. Don't get over your skis. You still have a lot of convincing to do. And are you sure that the poll you spoke of is legitimate?"

"It was the January 31, 2025 edition of Prophecy News Watch. I can print it out and give you a copy."

"Don't bother."

"Maybe, then, we should get back to the importance of Family and Love in God's system. From what I've read so far of the Bible the notion of Family is primary. And, of course, you know what John has said about Love, that it's dominant in the very nature of God. And what about what God said in Genesis about the need for a complementary other for Adam? The problem of the wrong gender assignment to the Holy Spirit has, at the least, contributed to an indifference to God of many church goers and probably caused a large proportion of them to leave the Churches and dismiss God from their minds.



It may even have caused some either to accuse our Lord of hypocrisy or to embrace as acceptable some practices that Scripture denounces as sinful. Of particular concern is the male-dominated, weakly masculine Godhead, which can be understood by some to imply a benign attitude of God toward either weak masculinity or outright homosexual behavior. The nature of this virtually universal problem is twofold, infecting both the Catholic and Protestant branches of Christianity: the first of these misconceptions is that gender does not belong within the spiritual realm, God being more pure and above that sort of thing; second, that the Holy Spirit is either sexually neutral or weakly masculine.”

“You do realize, don’t you, that gender isn’t all that important to God? In fact, it doesn’t even exist in the heavenly realm.” He sipped at his coffee with a smirk.

“I know where you got that idea. It’s radically untrue.”

“Are you. . .” His eyes took on a confrontational cast.

“Please let me finish what I’m trying to say. The lack of femininity in the Godhead feeds off the perceived lack of gender in the spiritual domain. The perception of that probably hasn’t been intentional, but was merely caused by a basic shallowness of understanding. The root of this misperception is Jesus’ response in Matthew 22:29 and 30, that in heaven humans don’t marry. This is reinforced by Paul’s statement in Galatians 3:28 that in heaven there is neither male nor female.”

“There you have it. It’s from Scripture itself, if you’ll please note. And it doesn’t waffle about with wishy-washy wording. It undercuts everything you’ve said.”

“Please note that in Matthew 22 Jesus spoke in that context of the power of God:

“Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the Scriptures, nor the power of God. For in the resurrection, they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are like the angels of God in heaven.”



“On the surface the passage in Matthew 22 does indeed seem to say it all, but how can the lack of gender in heaven represent the power of God? I would think that it says the exact opposite. What is neglected is Paul’s clarifying description in 1 Corinthians 12 that points to the actual situation in heaven. It’s all about the difference between the individual and the composite. Listen to what Paul had to say in that passage in the context of gender in the individual vs. the composite:

“Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God, who worketh all in all. But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit.

For to one is given, by the Spirit, the word of wisdom; to another, the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; to another, faith by the same Spirit; to another, the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; to another, the working of miracles; to another, prophecy; to another, discerning of spirits; to another, various kinds of tongues; to another, the interpretation of tongues. But all these worketh that one and the very same Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.

For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ. For by one Spirit were we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Greeks, whether we be bond or free; and have been all been made to drink into one Spirit. For the body is not one member, but many.

If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it, therefore, not of the body? And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it, therefore, not of the body? If the whole body were an eye, where were the hearing? If the whole body were hearing, where were the smelling? But now hath God set the members, every one of them, in the body, as it hath pleased Him. And if they were all one member, where were the body? But now are they many members, yet but one body.



And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of thee; nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you. Nay, much more those members of the body which seem to be more feeble, are necessary; and those members of the body, which we think to be less honorable, upon these we bestow more abundant honor; and our uncomely parts have more abundant comeliness. For our comely parts have no need; but God hath tempered the body together, having given more abundant honor to that part which lacked, that there should be no schism in the body, but that the members should have the same care one for another. And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honored, all the members rejoice with it. Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular. And God hath set some in the Church: first apostles, second prophets, third teachers; after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.”

“To summarize Paul’s discourse, we won’t marry each other, but as a group we will be married to Jesus Christ. This suggests that the same principle applies to the angels, who collectively comprise the Holy Spirit, who Himself is married to the Holy Father. It also suggests that if we wish to depart from the will of God, we can do so like the fallen angels, but at the loss of our souls.

“Resurrected humans are parts of the Body of the Church composed of individual components, who Himself in the aggregate is the Wife of Jesus as promised by Paul in Ephesians 5:31 and 32. Jesus in Matthew 22 also likens resurrected humans to angels, informing us that individual angels themselves are components of a greater collective, which as the feminine Holy Spirit is the divine Wife of God the Father. Note also that in His explanation to the Sadducees, Jesus chided them for not understanding the power of God. Power is consistent with an attribute possessed by God rather than a lack, which would be the case if heaven was genderless.

“The bottom line in this is that sexuality under the bounds set by God is a beautiful thing rather than something thought to be beneath the level of God. In fact, it was because Jesus was already betrothed to His Church that He remained celibate during His time on Earth. Moreover, this marriage, according to Romans 9:4, will be anything but trivial.



“Of course, the romantic nature of this marriage is explicitly presented in the Song of Solomon, which should cast away all doubts as to whether the marriage between Jesus and His Church is more than a mere formality. Moreover, as Jesus is presented in Scripture (Hebrews 1.3 and elsewhere) as being the express image of God, it is not much of a stretch that the Song might describe the union of the Holy Father with the Holy Spirit as well.

“How did something as beautiful as what God designed ever have been treated as all-too-earthly for God Himself? I’ll tell you how: the early Christians were still influenced by the Greek notion of dualism, that the heavenly realm was all good, while the material realm was all evil. The notion has nothing to do with the Christian faith, but everything to do with secular thinking. The negativity of this attitude about gender, coupled with the existing debauchery of the secular society, pushed the thought that gender doesn’t belong in heaven into a firm stance against anything having to do with sex, particularly regarding things godly. As a matter of fact, one Christian lady of that period enthusiastically extolled the beauty of her new born baby but then remarked upon how dreadfully disgusting was the way that it had been conceived. Another person, a man, attempted to have himself castrated to avoid the depravity of sexual experience. Another . . .

“Maybe you should cool down a little,” pastor broke in with an angry frown. “You’re starting to rant.”

“Okay. But I would suggest a greater root that goes all the way back to the Garden, where Adam and Eve ate of the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. Before they did so, they were unashamed of their nakedness. That initial lack of shame was spoken of in the Bible. The sins of the first couple were basically sexual, in that Eve, who was designed by God as the responder, committed adultery by responding to satan rather than her husband. She compounded the sin by initiating the eating to Adam, who God designed as the sole initiator. Adam, of course, committed his own sin by responding to Eve in violation of his designed nature as initiator. The information they acquired from the eating from that tree of knowledge must have included such a horrible understanding of the



perversion of sex that mankind would commit that it brought shame into their lives, which is also spoken of in the Bible. Millennia later, this shame drove our Christian Fathers into the great sin of tampering with Scripture despite their own opinion that they were being helpful to God. It's a real eye-opener to read how ugly they considered sex to be. They even attempted castration and some considered the marriage bed to be useful only in the production of children. And, of course, off and on, priests were required to be celibate. One wonder show many priests throughout the years were able to remain celibate throughout their lives. The Scriptural misunderstanding of the Holy Spirit was never benign. But now in the midst of society's chaotic decline, it is positively dangerous."

"You're going off again. Frankly, I find that to be distasteful. At any rate, I have a meeting to attend. Perhaps we'll talk again. I have to think about that."

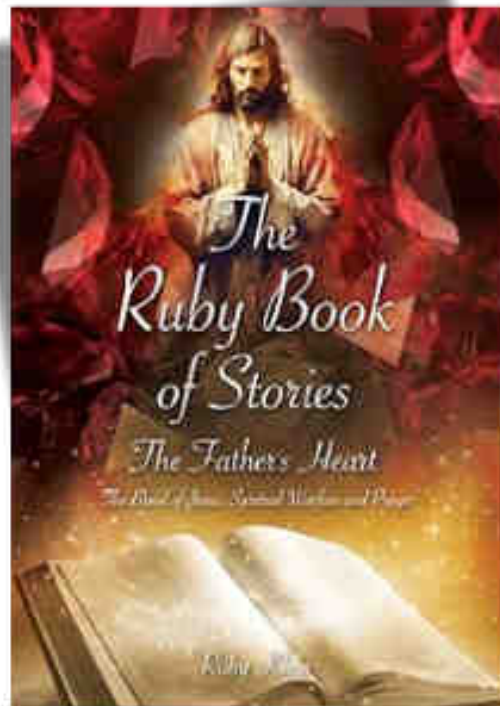
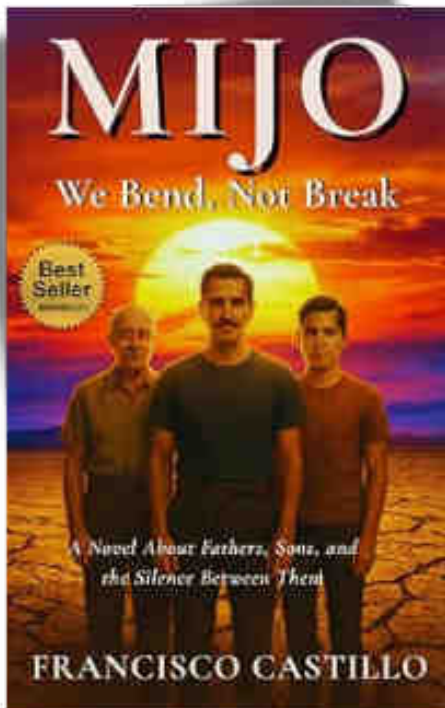
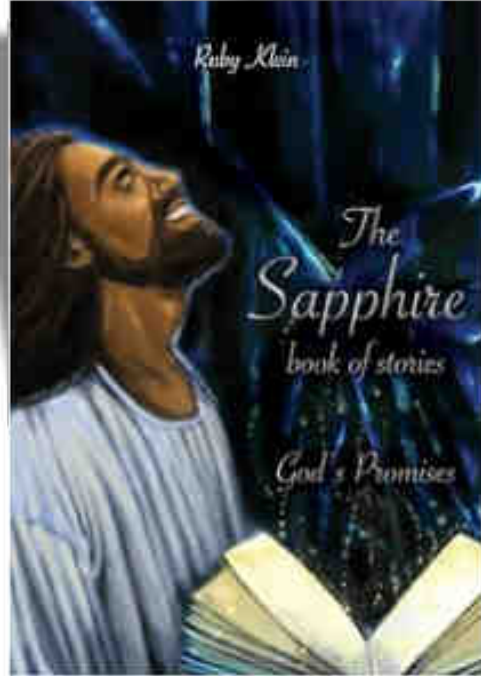
