This year, the Seawolf Privateers helped 87 local children start the school year prepared and confident, by providing the school supplies and necessities they needed to walk through those classroom doors ready to learn.

Thanks to the generosity of our supporters, **we were able to pour \$6,763.27 directly back into these children for the start of the new school year.**

For us, backpacks, notebooks, pencils, and school supplies are about much more than checking items off a list. They're about helping a child walk into school feeling like they have everything they need and nothing that sets them apart.
