

MASS/EVENT/NEWS

- In consideration of Father Martin's absence from Our Lady of Lourdes while he travels home to Ghana, the Mass schedule for the month of February and the first few days of March will be modified slightly. Saturday and Sunday Masses will be held as usual. Tuesday Friday weekday Masses will be Communion Services only presided over by Deacon Rick and Deacon Tom.
- Father Stan Szczapa (aka 'Father Stan') will be filling in for Father Martin during the three weekend Masses for the month of February. We are so grateful for his support during this time.
- UPDATE: Embry Health has opened their testing site in the parking lot alongside of the parish office. Hours are Monday Friday from 7:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m., Saturday 7:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m. and Sunday 1:00 p.m. 4:00 p.m. The testing is free, however you are asked to bring your health insurance card (if you have one!) when you come. Results will be sent directly to your phone. PCR testing is being provided. Results have been available (at this time) between 24-48 hours after testing. The site is open to everyone in the community, so share the news with those who may be interested. You may schedule an appointment with Embry Health at embryhealth.com This helps with the process when you arrive at the testing site. We will update this information as needed via Flocknote, in the bulletin and on the website.

Feast Day of Our Lady of Lourdes 2/11/2022

Pope Francis on Friday encouraged Catholics to ask Our Lady of Lourdes to intercede for them to have a heart more open to encountering other people and their needs. In a video message for the Feb. 11 feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, the pope explained that "encounter is always opening oneself to others." The opposite of encounter is closing one's heart," he said. "Mother, help us not to have closed hearts, because selfishness is a moth that gnaws at the heart from within." On Feb. 11, the Catholic Church celebrates the liturgical memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes. The feast day recalls when the Virgin Mary appeared to a young St. Bernadette Soubirous in a cave-grotto in southwestern France from Feb. 11 to July 16, 1858.
