Saturdays 2/8-2/29 -3/7-& 3/21 6:00 p.m.-8:30 p.m.

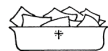
The workshops will be in the parish hall or one of the class-rooms. We will be conducting this training in Feb. and March to allow us to meet full parish compliance requirements.

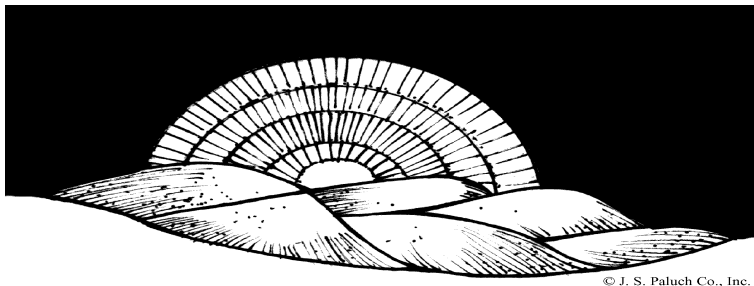
