FALL HOMEOWNER MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST

	Clear out any debris from gutters & downspouts and touch up paint.
	Test your roof and flashings for leaks by running water over them.
	Masonry surfaces need to have their mortar joints repaired (tuck-pointed).
	Inspect your crawlspace or basement for efflorescence, fungus, and mold.
	To prevent roof ice dams: 1. Inspect your roof and make sure it's in good condition. 2. Make sure your gutters and downspouts are clear of debris. 3. Install a water and ice shield on your roof. 4. Insulate your attic to keep heat from escaping. 5. Seal any gaps or cracks in your attic floor.
	Look for anything that could become airborne in a winter storm, such as loose shingles, siding, or trim.
	Seal up any cracks and openings on the outside of the house.
	Seal the gaps around window trim and door frames with caulk.
	Inspect the insulation on heat-ducts and water-pipes to ensure that they are in good condition.
	Inspect roof decks for signs of deterioration, damaged flashing, or compromised waterproofing.
	Clean and degrease all exterior concrete surfaces.
	All concrete and masonry surfaces should be sealed and protected.
	Test your furnace, clean the burners, and lubricate the pulleys.
	Open your fireplace damper and adjust it as needed.
	Clean your fireplace screen and doors and make any adjustments as needed.
	Inspect your chimney spark arrestor to ensure it's in good condition.
1	Clean lint from dryer duct and the interior of the dryer housing.
	Inspect water-supply hoses for your washing machine and clean the filters.
1	Lubricate door hinges and drawer glides.
