The dives are done at a slower pace in order to sharpen your skills to insure you are safe and all skills are mastered to make you a better and more confident diver. There are 4 dives required to complete.

- All Scuba gear (Mask, Snorkel, Fins and Boots are not included nor available to rent).

You will also need time to come into the shop before your pool dives to get fitted for your gear and review your material's (Takes 1 hour. Done Friday's or Saturday's).

To complete your Open Water Certification you will also need to do 4 Open Water Dives. These dives can be completed in the Spring/Summer time with us at either at Two Jack Lake or at Lake Chaparral. OR you can complete these dives some were warm on a vacation with your referral letter from your instructor.



Open Water elearning and Pool—\$350

The PADI elearning course gives you the flexibility and the convenience to complete all your knowledge development from a computer based program offered through PADI. You can start when you want and work at your own pace. All quizzes and exams are done from this program and your confined dives will be done within a group once you have completed. Just call to have this booked.

- Confined Water Dives in the pool. All scuba gear is provided.
