## Traditional Course—\$249

The PADI Open Water Diver Course is the basics of diving. This is your start of something fun and exciting. All our courses are performance based not timed based meaning we will give you as much time as you need in till your comfortable and your skills are mastered. This program consists of:

- Knowledge Development in which is a self study home program. Using your Open Water Crewpack and the videos provided for you when you signed up you will read the book in full and then watch the videos at your leisure. After you have done this you will get together with your instructor to go over your books, dive tables, and Quizzes and Exams and will be able to ask any questions you have. This only takes 1 evening
- Confined Water Dives in the pool. This step in your training is where the fun really starts. You will be practicing and demonstrating the skills you learned in your Knowledge Development. There is generally 2 pool sessions needed based on how well you complete the skills. These are done over 1 weekend or 2 evenings depending on the pool location.
