Sign a PDF from Your Phone or Tablet

Mobile devices have helped us eliminate a lot of printing from our lives. Articles can be bookmarked, directions live in an app and even lengthy PDF documents in need of signatures can be signed without printing, signing and scanning. Here are some apps that can help you complete this task:

- DocuSign this app offers a range of services, including options for individuals who are primarily looking to sign documents (which can be uploaded, signed and sent back for free) and for businesses that are looking to send documents for signature and receive them back within the platform (plans start at \$10 per month with one user).
- DropBox this app is known for cloud storage and collaboration, but recently added a PDF signature option. When you open a PDF in the app a pencil icon will appear at the bottom the screen that you can tap to add your signature. This feature is currently only available in iOS.
- **SignNow** similar to DocuSign this app has features for individuals and businesses with a tiered pricing model. In addition to letting you sign with a touchscreen signature, SignNow lets you upload a photo of your signature and can cleanly place it on documents. This app is developed by Barracuda, well-known for their security and data protection products. No surprise, document encryption is a touted feature of the app.

There are many more apps available that can be customized to your needs. So whether you're signing permission slips or managing contracts and leases, consider taking that process digital with a smartphone or tablet and a PDF signature application.
