I am very honored to be a part of an organization with so many hard working business owners and staff, all finding a way to get 'er done. Keep on keeping on!


### **Golf Outing August 10**

### **New Home Construction up nearly 40%**

According to information from the Wisconsin Builders Association, the latest new home construction numbers continue to rise - with 38.1 percent more permits pulled between January 1 and June 30 this year compared to the same timeframe in 2020.

The data, submitted by all municipalities across the state, show 7,008 permits were pulled in the first half of 2021 compared to 5,074 in the first half of 2020, an increase of 1,934. In quarter two alone there were 4,382 permits pulled, signifying the number of new home starts.

"The lack and competition of existing housing combined with low interest rates continue to play a huge role in the demand for new housing," said Wisconsin Builders Association (WBA) Executive Director Brad Boycks. "Even despite the high costs of building materials, we are excited to see the building industry continue to thrive as it's one that supports so many other industries across the state."

In the first half of 2021, 97 plats and 2,413 lots were approved. These numbers are on track to surpass 2020 totals, as there were 201 plats and 5,340 lots approved last year.

"The number of new starts and approvals of plats and lots are very encouraging," said WBA President Abe Degnan. "We have and continue to hope construction prices come down soon as it will continue to drive the positive upward growth of building."

### MABA helps with workforce center

On July 13, the Madison Area Builders

Association (MABA) participated in a
groundbreaking ceremony for a new facility to train
the next generation of construction industry
professionals. NAHB CEO Jerry Howard, Boys and
Girls Club of Dane County (BGCDC) First Chair Dr.
Leslie Petty and other community leaders took part
in the event.

Through a partnership with BGCDC, the new McKenzie Regional Workforce Center will serve as a skilled trades learning hub for local students.

MABA member John McKenzie spearheaded the development of the center. He purchased and donated the building, which will also serve as the future home of MABA's offices.

"These are great jobs and they're satisfying jobs but they're not being advocated for – they're not being taught in schools," said <a href="McKenzie during the ceremony.">McKenzie during the ceremony.</a> "The industry is primarily a bunch of old

white men and they're aging out...we need more women in the workforce, we need more people of color in the workforce."

Like many areas across the country, Wisconsin is facing a critical shortage of skilled construction workers, says Chad Lawler, executive director of MABA. Carpentry, electrical, plumbing, HVAC, framing crews and welding classes will be offered at the new training center.

The facility will reach up to 3,000 students who currently participate with BGCDC through after-school and weekend programs. Elementary school students will have the opportunity to take introductory classes and middle schoolers will learn about the trades at an intermediate level. Students ages 16 and older will be invited to participate in hands-on experiences with comprehensive instruction.

"The ultimate goal is not just to introduce the students into the trades but to also teach them leadership and entrepreneur skills, as well as how to run a business," said Lawler.

The workforce center is expected to welcome students in the fall of 2022.
