Scholarship deadline March 15

The Wolf River Builders Association Scholarship offers a scholarship(s) (up to 3 individuals), with the possibility of an individual receiving up to \$1500.

This is presented to a student or students who are continuing their education in a building-associated trade.

The scholarship is payable in one lump sum to be used for the initial semester at an accredited college, university, junior college, technical college, trade or vocational school or other approved educational organization.

Criteria for selection is as follows:

- 1. Graduating senior of a high school located in Shawano, Oconto or Menominee counties.
- 2. Show financial need.
- 3. Proven leadership ability.
- 4. Good moral character.
- 5. Continuing their education in a building associated field.
- 6. Scholarship request must be made on WRBA application.
