

### *How much does skating really cost?*

A few examples of regular training expenses include:

New skates:

Boots: \$900

Blades: \$750

New competition dress: \$1500

Coaching fees: \$100/hour

Competition fees: \$1,500-\$2,500

Travel for competitions: \$12,000-  
\$17,000
