Just last month it was utilized for its first outdoor service during the Blessing of the Pets Service. In the future it is envisioned that this area can be utilized for weddings, baptisms, funerals and outdoor services. This is all a part of the vision that is being built for growing the congregation of Faith. Church is where you are and sometimes that may well be out in the Gardens of Faith. As Pastor Todd put so eloquently at our recent planning meeting and I paraphrase rather poorly, Church is not a structure but rather what we do. So, don't be reluctant to ask to do Church out in the Gardens. It is there for each and all of us. Stop and visit, spend a little time or a lot, take a moment to think, dream or pray. Last month Gary Lagerstedt explained a bit how the Columbarium itself func-

tions. Then on Wednesday, November 8, I will be participating in one of the Feast educational opportunities exploring the costs of funerals and options. While no one wants to think about their mortality it is important to plan so your loved ones don't have to do that thinking when they are least prepared to do so. We look forward to seeing many of you there. Planning is not just for those in the older stages of their life.

We will also be forming the ongoing Columbarium Committee or Board at the next annual election. This was approved as a by-law change last year. The Nominating Committee will be considering 2 lay persons to be on this Committee. If that is something that you are interested in please let Pastor Todd know. These positions provide policy direction for the columbarium and it is always good to have people that have an interest in participating stand for election.
