Emergency Preparedness at Faith

What is an AED?

An automated external defibrillator (**AED**) is a portable electronic device that automatically diagnoses the life-threatening cardiac arrhythmias of ventricular fibrillation and pulseless ventricular tachycardia, and is able to treat them through defibrillation, the application of electricity which stops the arrhythmia.

Did you know we have this device in our Welcome Center? If ever there is an emergency and it is needed you should know where it is. Take a look at the pictures and get familiar with it's placement. It's a life saving device that we should all be aware of.

Severe Weather Shelter Area

If you are at Faith during a severe weather incident please walk down the hallway past the nursery and go into the Sunday school hallway. Shut all the doors and stand up against the walls. If the hallways are too crowded the bathrooms are also good rooms to go inside of. A room without windows is always best.



Church Security

Our east double doors are always locked during office hours Monday through Friday. It is an area where the Welcome Center Volunteer and the Office Administrator cannot see if someone has come into the church. Please use the front main entrance and check in at the Welcome Center or with the Office Administrator. It's good practice to know who is in the church at all times. Thank you!


